

File your city & residential tax to complete your pension procedures

The filing period for city and prefectural residence tax and national health insurance premiums for the fiscal year 2015 is between February 16 (Mon)~ March 16 (Mon). If you would like to apply for national pension premium exemptions, welfare or disability pensions, you must complete filing your city and prefectural taxes. Your records will be used to determine the results of your application and will help your application process to go smoothly. *Premium contributions are approved as a "social insurance" contribution" tax deduction.

▶ Roads closed around RyCom intersection on HWY 85— Period Extended

Lanes around Rycom intersection on highway 85 are currently regulated (closed) due to midnight construction (printed in the December 2014 issue of Okinawa City Koho/ Newsletter). Bus lanes on HWY 58 extended as of February 2

The bus lane from Isa, Ginowan City to Kumoji, Naha City will be extended from 8.8 kilometers (about 5.5 miles) to 10.4 kilometers (about 6.5 miles) in the morning. In the evening, the bus lane from Kumoji to Ameku will be extended 6.8 kilometers (about 4 miles) to Makiminato, Urasoe City.
