Okinawa City provides subsidies for part of school expenses to parents who have financial difficulty in their public elementary and junior high school children's school attend-



### Disability Benefit System

特別障碍者手当・障碍児福祉手当の制度について

### Special Disability Benefits (at least 20 years old)

People who lives at home with a severe disability, and needs special and constant assistance throughout the day.

\*People who are staying at a care facility or are hospitalized are <u>not</u> eligible for this benefit.

### Welfare Benefits for Disabled Children (under 20 years old)

People who lives at home or hospitalized with a severe disability, and needs special and constant assistance throughout the day.

\*Children who are staying at a care facility are <u>not</u> eligible for this benefit.

**How to apply:** You must provide a doctor's statement and other documents.

Please contact the division in charge for details.

### The revision of the amount of Special Disability (Children/ Welfare) Benefit

Based on the National Price Index for the year 2022, which was disclosed as of January 20, 2023, and the amount of benefits will <u>increased at 2.5%</u> after April, 2023.

Special Disability Benefits: **¥27,980** (¥27,300 in FY 2022)

### Welfare benefits for Disabled Children:¥15,220 (¥14,850 in FY 2022)

\*If you are already receiving benefits, please notify *Shogai Fukushi Ka* of any major changes, such as a change to your name or address, if you entered a care facility, are in a hospital for more than three months, or the beneficiary is deceased. If you continue receiving benefits without submitting the appropriate notice, you will be required to return the full amount that you have received.

## ▶ FY 2023 Amount of Child Rearing Allowance for Single Parents & Special Child Rearing Allowance 令和5年度児童扶養手当・特別児童扶養手当額

The amount of child rearing allowance for single parents and special child rearing allowance for the fiscal year 2023 will increase by 2.5 % based on the National Consumer Price Index 2022 published on January 20, 2023.

### Child Rearing Allowance for Single Parents for the Fiscal Year 2023 (per month)

\*All amounts shown below are based on full payment.

1st child: ¥44,140 (Previous year amount + ¥1,070)

2nd child: ¥10,420 (Previous year amount + ¥250)

3rd child or later: ¥6,250 (Previous year amount +¥150)

### Special Child Rearing Allowance for the Fiscal Year 2016 (per month)

Level 1: ¥53,700 (Previous year amount + ¥1,300) Level 2: ¥35,760 (Previous year amount + ¥860)

#### ► Pneumococcal Vaccination For The Elderly

令和5年度 高齢者肺炎球菌予防接種

If you have not received this **pneumococcal vaccine (23-Valent)** before, and are eligible age under the list shown below, you will be able to receive it for free.

Vaccination Period: <u>Until March 31, 2024 (Sun)</u> <u>Please make sure you bring your resident card.</u>

Those who are registered residents of Okinawa City on the day of vaccination

Vaccination Fee: Covered by government.

This is a **one time** vaccination. **<u>\*\*Please note!</u>** If you have already received this **pneumococcal vaccine (23-Valent)**, you will **not** be eligible to receive it at the subsidized rate.

Where you can get vaccinated:

Any designated medical facility. (Fee is covered only when you receive it at the designated medical facilities.)

\*Those who are between 60 and 64 years old with heart, kidney, respiratory function or HIV related immunity disorder (equivalent to physical disability level 1) are also eligible to this vaccination. \*Vaccination types and schedules in foreign countries (including military bases) may differ.

Please come to the service window in advance with your resident card and your vaccination history.

**April** is the payment deadline for the following tax:

Real-estate Tax (1st term). If you use automatic bank transfers, payments will be withdrawn on May 1. Make sure you have enough money in your bank account the day before!!



### Special Payment Application For Students (National Pension)

学生納付特例申請の受付申請開始

People, even students, must enroll in the National Pension System when they turn 20 years old. For students who earn less than the amount specified by the Japanese National Pension System, the "Special Payment System for Students" offers a reprieve from payments regardless of family income. If they do not apply and leave the pension premium unpaid, they may not be able to receive a disability basic pension for their disability caused by unexpected accidents or diseases in the future.

Calculated as the period required to receive the basic old-age basic pension (eligibility period)

Basic disability pension is a pension that can be received by those who are left disabled due to illness or injury.

Eligibility: Students of universities, colleges, high schools, or special technical schools under the School Education Act, or other institutes which offer courses for more than a year.

Start Date: April 1, 2023~~~

Required Documents: If the student applies: School certificate, student ID, etc. to prove that they are attending school. Certificates have to be issued April 1, 2023 or later.

If a proxy applies on behalf of the student: ID, inkan (a power of attorney will be required if the proxy is not from the same household). You can apply retroactively up to 25 months prior to the time of application.

### ► Anti body Test And Regular Vaccination For Rubella (40's -50's Male) 風疹抗体検査・予防接種事業

Men of eligible age who have never taken the MR vaccine can be tested for rubella antibodies at a medical institution, etc., and if their antibodies are low, you can receive the MR vaccine.

The voucher will be sent to eligible participants in April.

Eligibility: Male born between April 2, 1962 and April 1, 1979. Those who have received rubella antibody testing and vaccination at least once (between FY2019 to FY2022) are not eligible.

Location: Designated medical facilities, and Okinawa City Group Health Examination Venue (reservation re-

QUITEd). \*You cannot receive vaccination without taking antibody test.

Cost: Free (Covered by government)

Those who have lost their free coupon for antibody test can apply for reissuance. Please contact below for more information.



Period: From 8 May 2023 to 31 August 2023

Omicron strain compatible vaccination for those aged 12 to 64 vears other than the above will end on 7 May 2023.

If you wish to be vaccinated, please receive the vaccination as soon as possible.

### Supportive Measures in "National Health Insurance", "Medical Care System for the Elderly" Regarding COVID-19 infection

新型コロナウイルス感染症にかかる国民健康保険・後期高齢者医療制度「傷病手当金」 **Accident and Sickness Benefit** 

When an insured person is absent from work for medical treatment due to infection or suspected infection with the COVID-19 and is unable to receive all or part of their salary, etc. from the employer, the insured person will receive an "Accident and Sickness Benefit". The applicable period end on 7 May, 2023.

★ The statute of limitations expires after two years from the following day of each day on which you were unable to work, so please apply as soon as possible if you have not apply yet done so.
