One of the largest in Japan!

The reinforced-concrete statue is 18.79 meters high (in a sitting position). It is larger than the Great Buddha statue in Nara, and one of the largest reinforced-concrete

Saikichi Yamada, who erected the statue, is a great man!!

He was a businessman originally from Mino. He got the idea for the Moriguchizuke pickles that have become a popular product from this area. He was also the first man to produce and sell canned food in Aichi Prefecture. There are many facilities that he established in addition to the Great Buddha statue in Shuurakuen. He was also involved in the start of Chukyoshinpo newspaper publication, and Atsuta Denki Kido (streetcar company). He was a member of the Nagoya Chamber of Commerce and Industry, Nagoya City Assembly, and Aichi Prefectural Assembly. Kitafuku, a company Saikichi established, still manufactures and sells Moriguchizuke pickles under the name of


Heishu Hosoi Memorial Hall and Tokai City Local History Museum MAPPD-3


In the hall there is the "Heishu Memorial Exhibition Room," where Heishu's paintings and writings are on exhibit, the "Heishu Hall," an information section, and the Oumeikan, a lecture hall named after the school he opened in Edo. It is a memorial hall where you can relive the teachings of Heishu Hosoi. His words in calligraphy writing still touch the hearts of those who read them.








Heishu Hosoi Born 1728 - deceased 1801

Born in Tokai City, Aichi, he was a scholar who significantly influenced school and social education in the domain. He is particularly famous for being the first principal of Owari Domain's Meirindo School, and the teacher of Harunori (Yozan) Uesugi, the lord of the Yonezawa Domain. He is the pride of Tokai City as one of the great men originating from the city. Tokai City has made a sister city agreement with Yonezawa City (the city Harunori Uesugi originated from). The words Heishu Hosoi sent to Harunori Uesugi, "Yunarukana yuniarazushite naniwomotte okonawanya" meaning "Whatever you do, you must have courage" became the root of the cultural institution "Yunaru." Heishu Hosoi is the model for Tokai City's character, "Heishu-kun."



Yozan Uesugi Born 1751 - deceased 1822

A feudal lord during the mid Edo Period (1603-1868), and the 9th lord of Dewa Province, Yonezawa Domain. He restructured the Yonezawa Domain, which was on the verge of returning its land to the shogunate. He is famous for having been a prominent lord during the Edo Period. Pilgrimage Experience Chita Shikoku Hallow Ground

The pilgrimage to 88 Temples in the Chita Peninsula is one of the famous 3 major Shikoku pilgrimages (the other two being the pilgrimage to 88 Temples in Sasaguri Shikoku (Fukuoka) and the pilgrimage to 88 Temples in Shodoshima (Kagawa).) The route consists of 88 temples in different areas, 3 founding temples and 7 additional temples for a total of 98 temples. Located in the Chita Peninsula, the pilgrimage route is 194 km long, and can be started from any point. Go on a pilgrimage to find happiness and be sure to get your red stamp on your copy of the sutra at each stop!





Miroku Temple MAP > C-4

The 83rd temple of the Chita Shikoku pilgrimage.
The temple is impressive with countless big red lanterns decorating the octagonal Hokyoin-to Pagoda in the center.
Circling this Hokyoin-to Pagoda dockwise 3 times is said to make your wish come true.



Gennyu Temple MAP D-4

The 84^{th} temple of the Chita Shikoku pilgrimage. Statues of four heavenly kings (Jikoku-ten, Zocho-ten, Komoku-ten, and Tamon-ten) enshrined at the tower gate are worth seeing.



Seisui Temple MAP D-3

The 85th temple of the Chita Shikoku pilgrimage. This is a convent treasuring openness and accepting all that seek asylum. Sho Kanzemon Bosatsu, which is not open to the public, is known to be the work of Dengyou Daishi and is designated a cultural asset by Tokai City.

Kannon Temple MAP > C-3

The 86th temple of the Chita Shikoku pilgrimage. Famous as the temple where Heishu Hosoi received his first schooling. The sight of a huge camphor tree, said to be over 700 years old is simply breathtaking. Kannonji Chochin Festival is famous as an eccentric night festival with a competition to snatch offered

Historical Sites in Tokai City



Matsusaki Shiseki Park MAP▶B-4 lwayaguchi Tumulus MAP▶B-5

A famous ruin on Chita Peninsula related to salt making from the late Tumulus Period to the late Heian Period. The salt production system and the large amount of eartherware being unearthed attract attention.



Narihira Tumulus MAP▶D-4

This is the tower of Ayame, a bdy of the court who died of a broken heart after coming to this land to be with the man she loved, Ariwara-no-Nanihira. Of the five tower statues, the one that is said to be most aesthetically pleasing is called the Nanihira Tomulus.




Iwayaguchi Tumulus MAP ▶ B-5
A structure from about the end of the 6th century. It has the largest scale horizontal stone chamber on the Chita Peninsula.



lmagawa Tumulus MAP▶B-5

The tomb of Yoshimoto Imagawa, who lost the battle against Nobunaga Oda in the Battle of Okehazama. It is said that the inscription "義基 (Yoshimoto)" priest o was intended to prevent discovery by the enemy. rumor the



Yokosuka Palace MAP▶B-4

A second house built by Mitsutomo Tokugawa, the second lord of Owari, in 1666. There is a stone monument and a guide board that tells the story of the time.



Choeki Tumulus MAP▶C-3

This monument was built to honor the holy spirit of Nagamasu, who was the priest of Houkoku Temple. Many people visit the monument because of a rumor that says all wishes will come true to those who visit. Written wishes are hung on the wall of the temple hall.



Suwa Shrine MAP▶B-5

A famous shrine attracting visitors for the first prayer of the year. On the premises of the Suwa Shrine is a monument inscribed with a Tanka poen about Ayuchigata, which became the origin for the name of Aichi Prefecture.



♦ Cherry Blossom Festival →see P.2



In the Oike Park, there are 1,100 cherry trees representing 7 varieties. When the trees are in bloom, the area is lit up at night. Events such as the tea ceremony conducted by the Shimin Bunka Kyokai (Citizen's Culture Association), and joint presentations are held.

♦ Tokai Fireworks Festival



Everyone will speak of these fireworks as the most exciting event of the summer. The first fireworks display was first held the year following the establishment of Tokai City and remains an ongoing and important part of the City's history. Today, approximately 4,000 fireworks are set off with large star mines set off every 5 minutes. Many people from both inside and outside of the city come for the event. The grand mine star is the climax of the event. Watching the Eisa dance of Okinawa, an event held in a nearby baseball field, is also alot of find.

The festival is held concurrently with the annual celebration of Atago Shrine in Yokosuka-machi. The main attraction is Donden, which is carrying the float and spinning it around. The sight of the float being hoisted up will take your breath away!

The festival is held concurrently with the annual celebration of Omiya Shrine. Four large floats dazzle the crowds with a Donden performance complete with musical accompaniment. Dances by mechanical dolls are also a must see.

Leaves of Japanese maples and 7 varieties of large and small trees surround the Great Buddha in Shuurakuen as they turn red. Why not stop by the Oumeian tea ceremony room, to relax and enjoy some Japanese tea? There are also several other events held during this season as well.

This is the satellite venue of one of the largest dance festivals in Japan staged in midsummer Nagoya. Witness these spectacular dances as the end of the summer nears.

A traditional festival in the Nawa District, in which huge dolls called Shojo Metta carrying Barin (large pieces of bamboo that have been split at the bottom) are paraded through the town accompanied by festive music.
