▶ Please Note: October is the payment deadline for the following taxes:

Resident tax (3rd term)/ Long-term care insurance premium (5th term)/ National health insurance premium (4th term)/Medical care for the elderly insurance premium (4th term).

If you use automatic bank transfers, payments will be withdrawn on <u>Oct 31st (Tuesday)</u>

Please make sure you have enough money in your bank account the day before.

The COVID-19 Autumn additional Vaccine will start on September 20th to March 31st 2024.

<Vaccination Period for Additional Autumn now>

From September 20 (Wed) to March 31(Sun),2024.

Eligibility: Requires completion of both the first and second vaccinations, with a minimum of 3 months passed (If you are vaccinated by Takeda, you need a minimum of 6 months to have passed) since the last vaccination. Individuals age 6 months and older.

Vaccination Voucher will be mailed to residences age over 65 years or people who have done vaccinated on this last spring.

For those who under 65 of age, you'll need the voucher.

Please call vaccination call center for issue the voucher.

If you have unused voucher, you can also use it for get vaccinated. People who wish to get vaccinated, please apply to obtain a voucher.

▶ Pensioner Support Benefits

If you are living off a pension, additional financial support ("Pensioner Support Benefits") will be given if you earn less than a certain amount. You have to apply to receive this benefit.

Eligibility

satisfy the following:

✓ You are age 65 or above.

✓ All your household members are non-taxed for resident tax.

✓ Your total annual income including pension and other income does not exceed ¥878.900.

♦ You are receiving "Disability Basic Pension" or "Basic Pension for the Bereaved":

✓ Your income in the previous year does not exceed ¥4,721,000. + Dependents Numbers x ¥380,000.-

How To Apply

(1) If you are already receiving pension benefits and newly receiving the Pension Support Benefits:

The Japan Pension Service (JPS) will send an announcement after September 1st eligible people on how to apply. Fill out the enclosed postcard ("年金生活者支援給 付金請求書") and submit it to JPS.

2 If you started receiving pension :

Visit the Pension Office or Pension Section in Okinawa City Hall to apply for both pension and additional benefit. Please be aware of suspicious phone calls or invitations from the person pretending to be the Japan Pension Service or the Ministry of Health, Labour and Welfare.

Neither the Japan Pension Service nor the Ministry of Health, Labour and Welfare will call you to ask for your family structure, financial institution account numbers or PIN numbers, or ask you for a fee or other money.
