# **Fall Fire Prevention Exercise**

A fall fire prevention exercise will be held for one week throughout Japan from November 9 (Saturday)-15 (Friday). The slogan for this year's exercise is: Keep the alarm in your heart ON until you turn it OFF!

 When using a stove burner, don't leave its side. Don't leave burnable/ flammable object lying around the house.

### Flu Vaccination For Those 65 Years Old Or Older



If you are a resident of Okinawa City and at least 65 years old, you can receive the flu vaccination for a subsidized fee. Those eligible will receive a notification in the mail (see left image) from the Kodomo Sodan Kenko Ka (Child Consultation/ Health Division). Where can you get vaccinated? You can get vaccinated at any

designated medical facility within Okinawa City. (There is a list of medical facilities included in the notification sent. If you have any questions about medical facilities outside of Okinawa City, please contact the Kodomo Sodan Kenko Ka. Fees for vaccinations received outside of Okinawa City will not be subsidized.) How much is the vaccination? The subsidized fee is ¥1,000.

(¥3,000 will be covered by public expenditure.) Those receiving welfare will be exempted from paying the fee.

ATTENTION! You can only receive the subsidized vaccination once during this period. You will have to pay the full fee for any other additional vaccination. Kodomo Sodan Kenko Ka (Child Consultation/ Health Division Vaccination Section) ext. 2232, 2233

What does the phrase *cavity prevention* bring to mind? Yes, brushing your teeth is vital in maintaining the health of your teeth, but there may be some of you who brush your teeth daily and yet end up with cavities or gum disease. Are you aware that what you drink has a lot to do with cavity prevention? Many soft drinks and carbonated drinks are loaded with sugar, but we seem to be more conscious about the amount of sugar in our sweets and candy than in a single beverage. The risk of developing cavities become even

areater if you sip on a sugary beverage throughout the day since the ingredients remain in your mouth! You don't have to vow to never drink a sugary beverage again. Instead, get into the habit of rinsing out your mouth with water after you've finished your drink, or drinking water or tea after you've brushed your teeth. We'd all like to enjoy our meals with our own teeth for as long as we can, wouldn't we? In order to do so, keeping our mouth healthy is essential. Remember to visit your dentist every 6 months!

# Low Carbon Construction Plan Approval System

The tei-sanso kenchiku-butsu shinchiku-to keikaku no nintei seido (low carbon construction plan approval system) has begun. This system approves new housing construction in appointed districts that satisfy requirements for CO<sup>2</sup> reduction. If approved, the owner may receive home mortgage tax cuts and other preferential treatment. This is limited to new housing construction. Okinawa Prefecture and its 41 municipalities will reinforce resident tax payments during December 1st-31st. Delinguent taxpayers who fail to make payments despite being notified more than once may be subject to property seizure or other coercive collection.
