The Story of Koza Monogatari Musical

It was during the 1950s, the time when Okinawa City was called Koza...

Koza was undergoing rapid revival after the war, with an influx of workers engaged in US base construction and other businesses related to the US military. For children and women who had lost families in the war, Masa Shimamoto, modeled after Masu Shima, put in her own funds to build facilities to provide employment and child protection. She devoted herself to the development of the social welfare system during those times.



When she came back to the child protection facility, Masa Shimamoto, the big mom of the US base town, dealt with the military government and fantastically and decisively solved complicated problems with her native bravery. 

▶ **障害年金** (Basic Disabiliy Pension)

You are eligible to receive basic disability pension benefits if you have been left disabled as a result of an illness or injury while enrolled in the national pension system. Even if you are under age 20 (and not yet enrolled in the national pension system) and your disability is recognized to be a 1st or 2nd degree disability based on the National Pension Act, you may also be eligible to receive basic disability pension benefits as long as you meet the following requirements.

Your eligibility depends on your enrollment in the national pension system at the point of your first hospital visit for your illness or injury, the condition and level of your disability, and your tax payment situation.

Benefit Amount for the FY 2014 (fixed amount): ¥966,000 (1st degree) ¥772,800 (2nd degree) ***Important:** You may not be eligible to receive disability benefits even if you are issued a disability certificate. For more information, please contact your nearest pension or municipal office.

Are you aware of the new tsunami warming system? Japan Meteorological Agency

Tsunami Warning/Advisory categories and action to be taken

	Estimated maximun	n tsunami height	Action to be taken	Expected damage
	Quantitative expression	For huge earthquakes		
Major	over 10 m (10m < height)		Evacuate from coastal or river areas immediately to safer places such as high ground or a tsunami evacuation building.	Wooden structures are expected to be completely destroyed and/or washed away; anybody exposed will be caught in tsunami currents.
Major Tsunami Warning	10m (5m < height ≤ 10m) Huge	Tsunami waves are expected to hit repeatedly. Do not leave the evacuation location until Tsunami Warnings are cleared.		
Varning	5m (3m < height ≤ 5m)		Keep evacuating to higher and higher ground wherever possible!	(Most wooden structures washed away due to the tsunami in 2011)
Tsunami Warning	3m (1m < height ≤ 3m)	High	Educational video "Escape the Tsunami" (JMA)	Tsunami waves will hit, causing damage to low-lying areas. Buildings will be flooded and anybody exposed will be caught in tsunami currents. Toyokoro- tho (2003)
Tsunami Advisory	1m (20cm ≤ height ≤ 1m)	(N/A)	Get out of the water and leave coastal areas immediately. Do not engage in fishing or swimming activities until Advisories are cleared.	Anybody exposed will be caught in a strong tsunami currents in the sea. Fish farming facilities will be washed away and small vessels may capsize.

- Tsunamis may hit before warnings are issued if the source region is near the coast. Be sure to evacuate when shaking occurs.

- Tsunami heights may exceed estimations due to coastal topography and other factors in some regions. Evacuate to higher ground. - Tsunami Forecasts (Slight Sea Level Change) are issued if the estimated tsunami height is less than 20 cm and no damage

is expected, or if slight sea level changes are expected after Tsunami Advisories are cleared.
