

Disaster Prevention Column Disaster Prevention Tidbits

防災コラム 防災まめ知識

"Evacuation sites 避難場所" and "shelters避難所" An evacuation site is a place to temporarily escape from the danger of a disaster. Evacuation shelters are temporary places for people who cannot stay at home due to a disaster. In addition to evacuation centers such as schools and public facilities, there is "distributed evacuation".

What is evacuation?

Going to elementary and junior high schools and public facilities is not the only way to evacuate. If your home is in a safe location, you do not need to go to an evacua-tion site. "Evacuation" means "to avoid difficulties (disasters)", in other words, to ensure safety.

Distributed evacuation

evacuating to a remote location via nepotism With prior approval, evacuate to the homes of relatives or acquaintances for safety.

Evacuation of hotels, etc.

Evacuate to a safe hotel or inn.

Evacuation in a car or tent

If it is unavoidable, evacuate to a private vehicle or set up a tent in a safe place for shelter.

What is the difference between an evacuation site and a shelter?

【Evacuation site避難場所】

Parks, plazas, and buildings where people can take emergency shelter to protect their lives from disasters. It is a place to ensure personal safety, to check on the condition of the residents, and to confirm the safety of the residents.

Where?... Sports grounds, parks, plazas, tsunami evacuation buildings, etc.

【Shelter避難所】

This is a building where evacuees temporarily live together until the danger of disaster is over or those who cannot return to their homes due to disaster.

Where?... School gymnasiums, school buildings, public facilities, etc.

Evacuation sites and shelters differ in terms of the facilities they cover and how they are used, so be sure to check in advance.
