The disaster prevention drill was held on November 5 (Thu) for all area in Okinawa City with more than 20,000 participants. This aimed to build awareness for disaster prevention

during an earthquake or tsunami. It was conducted under the assumption that there was a strong earthquake throughout Okinawa and giant tsunami alert was announced. Participants tried to evacuate to designated sites at each area with information given through the IP radio.

Administrative Announcements

► Notice Concerning Rinji Fukushi Kyufu Kin (Temporary Welfare Allowance)

Application Deadline: January 15, 2016 (Fri)

Application by mail has to be postmarked by the last day of the application period.

- ■Eligibility: Residents of Okinawa City who are exempted from residential tax for the FY 2015. However, the exceptions are the following:
- Dependents of a residential tax payer.
- Beneficiaries of public assistance.
- ***Applicant must have their resident status at the time they are approved to get the allowance.
- ■Amount of allowance: 6,000 yen per eligible person (This is a one-time payment allowance.)

■Steps to Apply: The application form will be sent to eligible persons (or those who can be eligible) from Okinawa City Hall. Fill out the form, stamp your *inkan* and attach the documents required. After the application is accepted, the payment will be made to your bank account in order of applicants whose eligibility is confirmed. (It will take about two months.)

Notification regarding *Kosodate Setai Tokurei Kyufukin* (Temporary Allowance for Families with Small Children) Please apply ahead of time if:

- 1. You haven't submitted your current status notice.
- 2. You received the notice of Kosodate Setai Tokurei Kyufukin (Temporary Allowance for Families with Small Chil-dren) from Okinawa City.
- 3. You are a government employee.
- ■Application Period: December 11, 2015 (Fri)

■Where to Apply: If #1 applies to you, visit Kodomo Katei Ka (Children's Welfare Division)/ For #2 & #3, visit the administration office on basement level 2 of Okinawa City Hall

► Furusato Nozei (Local Town Support Tax) A system to support your hometown Okina

A system to support your hometown, Okinawa City.

What is Furusato Nozei...?

This system allows you to contribute to your hometown, Okinawa City, by making a voluntary tax donation.

How does it work?

If you make a local town support tax donation to any municipality more than 2,000 yen, you will get a deduction on your income tax (for the current year) and residential tax (for the following fiscal year) up to the defined limit. To receive the deduction, you must pay income tax and residential tax to Japan and are required to submit your receipts for local town support tax payments.

You can choose from specific categories how your support tax will be used in Okinawa City:

Support for the City of Eisa/ Support for the Children's City/

Mayor's Choice (Support for Education, welfare or urban improvement etc..)

► Regarding National Pension Premium Payment

To make a payment for national pension premium, you can use the payment slip which is sent by Japan Pension Service and pay at your nearest <u>banking facilities</u>, <u>post offices</u>, <u>convenience stores</u> and <u>ATMs</u>. You can also pay by credit card and through the internet.

To prevent from forgetting or getting behind on your payments, you can also make automatic payments using your bank account. This will allow you to make advanced payment at discounted prices as follows:

Discounted price for advanced payments (FY 2015):

Advanced payment for a month

→ ¥50 discount (for the month)

Advanced payment for 6 months

→ ¥1,060 discount (for the 6 months)

Advanced payment for a year

→ ¥3,920 discount (for the year)

Advanced payment for two years

→ ¥14,800 discount (for the two years)

Please make sure you make payments within the given payment due date.


Clean Day in Okinawa City

▶ Announcement Regarding the Basic Resident Register Card

The issuance of Basic Resident Register Card will end.

With the starting of the "Social Security and Tax Number (My Number) System" and individual number to be issued after January 2016, the issuance of Basic Resident Register Card* will end on December 28 2015. (If identification reference is required, the application has to be submitted no later than Monday, December 14, 2015.)

You cannot keep both Basic Resident Register Card and Individual Number Card (your Basic Resident sued. Register Card will be collected at the issuance of your Identification Number Card).

*If you don't acquire an Individual Number Card, you can use your current Basic Resident Register Card as long as it's valid.

The issuance of Electronic Certificate on Basic Resident Register Card will End

With the starting of the "Social Security and Tax Number (My Number) System", the issuance of Electronic Certificate* on Basic Resident Register Card will be concluded on December 22, 2015. If you wish to get an electronic certificate newly issued or updated on Basic Resident Register Card, make sure you apply by December 22, 2015, 17:00. This applies to those who has one that expires after January 2016.

After January 2016, the electronic certificate will be issued only on your identification number card but be careful because there is a possibility that the issuance of your My Number Card won't make it on time of the tax filing period.
