Application Period: Until March 31(Tue), 2020 Grant Amount: ¥50,000 per house (※58 houses left available for grants as of October 2019.)

Main Terms & Conditions:

- Your address is registered in Okinawa City.
- 2. You're not behind on tax payments.
- You can report information that is required by Okinawa City. Eligible Systems for the Grant:
- 1. The product is unused.
- 2. The product is NOT for lease.
- 3. You installed a home solar panel system in the house you live in, and have started or will be receiving services from the electric company since between Apr 1, 2019 and Mar 31, 2020.



➤ Your National Pension Contributions are Subject to Tax Deductions as "Social Insurance Contribution"

Your national pension premiums (contributions) are subject to tax deductions as "social insurance contribution" and you may be able to reduce the amount of your taxable income for the year.

Premiums subject to tax deductions include the total amount of contributions you paid between January to December 2019. Past payments, additional payments, and payments made on behalf of your dependent family members are also subject to tax deductions.

In order for deductions to apply, you must attach proof of

If you made payments between JAN 1 and SEP 30: post cards are sent at the beginning of November

If you made your first payment between OCT 1 and DEC 31: they will be sent at the beginning of February 2020

*If you requested for the reissuance of the deduction certificate, you will receive another document form in a A4 size envelope. If you receive it, you must attach it when you file.

► Have You Received the Pneumococcal Vaccination for the Elder-

ly?-Services Will Be Available No Later Than March 31, 2020-!

If you live in Okinawa City and wish to receive this vaccination, you can receive it for a subsidized rate. **XPlease note!** If you have already received the **pneumococcal vac-**

cine (23-Valent), you will not be eligible to receive it at the subsidized rate.

Vaccination Period:

Until March 31, 2020 (Tuesday)

Where you can get vaccinated: Any designated medical facility. (Fees for vaccinations received at other facilities will not be subsidized.) Please make sure you bring your resident card.

Vaccination Fee: Covered by government. *Those who are between 60 and 64 years old with heart, kidney, respiratory function or HIV related immunity disorder (equivalent to

► Applications for Premium Vouchers –It Is Approaching Deadline-!

Premium Vouchers are issued to ease the effects that the increase in consumption tax will have on households, while supporting the local economy.

①Premium Vouchers (for Households Exempt from Paying Resident Tax)

Those registered as an Okinawa City resident as of January 1, 2019, and are exempt from paying Resident Tax for the FY 2019.

However, the following persons are not eligible:

- · You are receiving support from someone who is paying taxes.
- · You are a receiving social welfare.

Process Flow:

- 1. Apply for vouchers (between Jun.-Dec.)
- 2. Get voucher exchange tickets in the mail in the end of Sep.
- 3. Purchase vouchers with the exchange tickets (by Jan.31 (Fri),
- 4. Use the vouchers (by Feb. 29(Sat), 2020)

2Premium Vouchers (for Households with Children)

Households with children born between April 2, 2016 and September 30, 2019.

Process Flow:

- 1. Get voucher exchange tickets in the mail (after the end of
- 2. Purchase vouchers with the exchange tickets (by Jan.31 (Fri),
- 3. Use the vouchers (by Feb. 29(Sat), 2020)
- *Applications are necessary for ①, not necessary for ②.
- *Households that fall under both 1 and 2 can apply for both.

*Eligible persons should receive exchange tickets in the mail around the end of September. Where you can get the vouchers: Bank in the Okinawa City Hall/ Koza Shinkin Bank/ Post Office in Okinawa City

Where you can get the vouchers: Supermarkets, convenience stores, gas stations, etc which are joined to this system.

Please note:

December is the payment deadline for the following taxes:

Real-estate tax (3rd term): Payment at the bank and also automatic payment due

Long-term care insurance premium (7th term)/ National health insurance premium (6th term)/ Medical care for the elderly insurance premium (6th term): Payment at bank and also automatic payment due on Jan 6.

If you use automatic bank transfers, make sure you have enough money in your bank account the day before.



► Subsidies for Home Renovation Construction.

➤ A 25% coverage rate (up to ¥250,000);

Barrier-free or energy-saving construction ➤A coverage up to ¥200,000);

Block wall removal -*This refers to block walls which are facing the road in a school zone, and higher than 1.2m.

Conditions:

- -The total construction cost must be more than ¥200,000.
- -Construction must be able to be completed and reported no later than the end of February 2020.
- *Application will be closed as soon as it fills the budget.
