► FY 2021 Subsidies For Installation of Solar And Energy-saving Equipment for Homes

Your national pension premiums (contributions) are subject to tax deductions as "social insurance contribution" and you may be able to reduce the amount of your taxable income for the year.

Premiums subject to tax deductions include the total amount of contributions you paid between January to December 2021. Past payments, additional payments, and payments made on behalf of your dependent family members are also subject to tax deductions. In order for deductions to apply, you must attach proof of premium payments when you file:

Additional Vaccination Against COVID-19 (3rd Dose)

Even when two doses of the new coronavirus vaccine are administered, it has been reported that the efficacy and immunogenicity of the vaccine decreases with time after vaccination. In light of this, the Ministry of Health, Labor and Welfare (MHLW) has announced a policy on the implementation of additional vaccinations against the new coronavirus. Okinawa City is also planning to establish a vaccination system based on the national policy. Eligibility: Those who received 2 doses of vaccination and it has already been more than 8 months before the 3rd dose.

*The decision will be made by the government based on scientific findings and the situation in other countries.

Garbage Collection Schedule During New-year Holiday

Burnable/ Non-burnable trash, Recyclables, Plants, Toxic waste:

Last day to pick-up: Dec. 31(Fri), 2021

Pick-up starts on Jan.4(Tue), 2022

Garbage should be put out by 8:00 a.m. on the appointed day in your area.

*Collection time before and after the holiday could change depending on the quantity of trash.

Bulk Trash: Call by **Dec 28(Tue)** for pick-up. However the collection can be schedule after January since there will be a concentration of applications in the end of the year.

To reduce and recycle waste, you must tie paper items with **paper string** after <u>January 4, 2022</u>. **NOTE:** Do not use string other than paper string (such as plastic string or twine).

We would like to ask all the residents for cooperation on sorting and reducing the trash.

Registration & Rabies Shots For Your Dog

Registration (Once in a lifetime) and annual rabies shot on the dogs aged of 91 days-old or older are obligated by a aw. However, **the annual rabies group shot at community centers has been cancelled to prevent the spread of the COVID-19.** Please make sure your pet receives a rabies shot at the veterinary clinic by the <u>end of the year</u> (Friday, December 31, 2021) if at all possible.

You can register your dog and receive a rabies vaccination tag at hospitals affiliated with the Okinawa Veterinary Medical Association listed below. Injections fees, consultation fees, consultations and times vary depending on each
