
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#### ▶ Please note:

December is the payment deadline for the following taxes:

Real-estate tax (3rd term): Payment at the bank and also automatic payment due on <u>Dec 25 (Thu)2025.</u>
Long-term care insurance premium (7th term)/ National health insurance premium (6th term)/ Medical care for the elderly insurance premium (6th term): Payment at bank and also automatic payment due on <u>Jan 5 (Mon)2026</u>.

If you use automatic bank transfers, make sure you have enough money in your bank account the day before.

National Pension Insurance premiums are fully deductible as social insurance premiums. If you wish to receive a deduction for social insurance premiums in your year-end adjustment(年末調整) or tax return(確定申告), please use the "Deduction Certificate for Social Insurance Premiums (National Pension Insurance Premiums) 社会保険料(国民年金保険料)控除証明書" sent to you by the Japan Pension Service.

※If you have paid the premiums for your family (only if you are obligated to pay them), you can add them to your own social insurance premium deductions.

%The premiums paid for prior years or additionally paid are also deductible.

After Late January 2026(electronic mailing). ※If you have registered on "Pension Net (ねんきんネット)" for electronic mailing, we will not send you the document by mail.

#### Shingles (Herpes zoster) Vaccine Immunization 帯状疱疹ワクチン

The medical questionnaire will be sent to those how are eligible and wish to receive this vaccination in FY2025. Eligibility to receive as a regular vaccination is valid only in FY2025.

Shingles (Herpes zoster) Vaccine Immunization requires you to receive twice depends on its type. Please schedule with plenty of time to spare so to complete vaccination within the designated period.

December 3rd – 9th : Disability Awareness Week 12月3日から9日は障害者週間

This week aims to promote the social participation of people with disabilities and deepen understanding and awareness of disability. People with disabilities may face difficulties in various aspects of daily life, but when those around them show understanding and provide consideration and support, it broadens the scope of their independence.

The social participation of people with disabilities is only possible with the awareness and understanding of those around them. Creating communities where everyone can live comfortably and with peace of mind begins with such steps.

Let's consider what we can do to realize an inclusive society where people with and without disabilities respect and support one another.

About the Act on the Elimination of Discrimination against Persons with Disabilities(障害者差別解消法)

This act prohibits administrative agencies and businesses from engaging in "unjust discriminatory treatment 1" against persons with disabilities and requires them to provide "reasonable accommodations 32, in order to realize an inclusive society

If you have experienced discrimination based on disability by an administrative agency or private business, or if you have any other concerns, please consult us.

\*1 Unjust discriminatory treatment refers to refusing or restricting the provision of services to persons with disabilities based on their disability without legitimate reason.

\*2 Reasonable accommodation refers to providing necessary support within a reasonable scope when a person with a disability faces difficulties. For example, installing a ramp to address a step when a wheelchair user enters a store.

The Act on the Prevention of Abuse of Persons with Disabilities (障害者虐待防止法)

This Act is a law aimed at preventing abuse against persons with disabilities and protecting their rights.

Abuse includes not only physical violence but also verbal and psychological abuse, neglect, and financial abuse. If you discover abuse, please report it promptly to your municipality's disability welfare office or call 110. The privacy of the reporter is protected. Consultation Desk

The Help Mark/Help Card

The Help Mark is a symbol used by people whose need for assistance or consideration is not recognizable from appearances to request consideration from those around them.

The Help Card is a tool containing emergency contact information and details of necessary support. It is used to request appropriate assistance from those around them during emergencies or disasters.

If you see someone wearing a Help Mark or carrying a Help Card, please show consideration by offering your seat on trains or buses, or offering assistance if they appear to be in need. If presented with one, please review the information provided and offer support within your capabilities.

The Help Mark can be issued through application at your local municipal office. The Help Card does not require an application. For details, please check the link.

Okinawa Prefecture *Chura* Parking "沖縄県ちゅらパーキング"(Parking Spaces for Persons with Disabilities, etc.) Permit System Chura Parking is a system designed to enable persons with disabilities, the elderly, and others with walking difficulties to smoothly use parking lots at public facilities, commercial establishments, etc. By displaying the permit in a visible location on your vehicle, you may use the designated parking spaces. We ask for your understanding and cooperation to ensure that those who require these designated parking spaces can use them smoothly.

There are two options to apply: in-person application (at your local municipal office) and mail-in application (to the prefectural office). For details, please check the link.
