



# Administrative Announcements



## Please Note:

February is the payment deadline for the following taxes:

Real-estate tax (4<sup>th</sup> term)/ Long-term care insurance premium (9<sup>th</sup> term)/

National health insurance premium (8<sup>th</sup> term)/ Medical care for the elderly insurance premium (8<sup>th</sup> term).

If you use automatic bank transfers, payments will be withdrawn on March 2 (Mon). Make sure you have enough money in your bank account the day before.

## ►National Health Insurance For Students Moving Out of The City For Schooling

National Health Insurance is usually enrolled in your city or town, but there is an exception for students who move out of Okinawa City to study.

If you are receiving financial support from your parents, you can continue to be enrolled in Okinawa City's National Health Insurance even after moving out (Article 116 of the National Health Insurance Act). If this applies to you, please follow the procedures below.

### ★New Enrollment Procedures :

You must apply when you move out of Okinawa City (or after moving out).

### ★Renewal Procedures (Required Annually) :

You must renew your insurance annually while you are a student. Please submit the "Notification Form" that arrives around March by the deadline.

### ★When You Lose Eligibility (Termination Procedures) :

You also need to submit a notification when you graduate or withdraw from school, or when you join your workplace's social insurance program.

\*If you do not submit the documents by the deadline, you may not be able to receive a new certificate of qualification at the time of renewal.

## ►Be careful not to forget to pay your national pension insurance premiums

国民年金保険料の納め忘れに注意

The amount of National Pension Premium between April, 2025 and March, 2026 is 17,510yen.

If you have not completed the payment by the due date, you will receive the reminder from Japan Pension Service(日本年金機構). If you leave the premium unpaid, the amount of the national pension annuity that you would receive in the future will be reduced, and also you might not be able to receive the other benefits such as old-age basic pension, disability basic pension, or basic pension for the bereaved.

Please make sure you have paid your pension premium.

### ◆How To Pay

- With payment slip-With credit card
- With automatic bank transfer (Apply in advance)
- With smart phone apps: Aeon pay, au Pay, d-payment, Pay B, Paypay, LINE Pay, Rakuten Pay, etc.



### ◆Discount Will be Applied For Advanced Payment!

If you pay in advance for certain payment periods, you will be able to receive a discount.

Please also consider about the "Early payment system" which allows you with the end-of-month payment for the premium of each month.

Application for advanced payment through automatic bank transfer/credit card:

### ●Advanced Payment Categories and the period of payments covered

6 months: April – September, 2026

12 months: April, 2026 – March, 2027

24 months: April, 2026 – March, 2028

### ●Application Deadline: End of February, 2026

### ●Date of Withdrawal: End of April, 2026

## ► Ban on Manufacturing and Import/Export of Fluorescent Lamps 蛍光灯の製造・輸出入禁止

Manufacturing and import/export of fluorescent lamps for general lighting purposes will be phased out by the end of 2027, depending on the type.

Switching to LED lighting saves energy.

Please plan to replace lighting in homes, offices, factories, etc., with LED lighting.

## ► Combined Measles And Rubella (MR) Vaccination In FY 2025 deadline

MR(麻しん・風しん) 予防接種

The deadline for the second round of MR (measles and rubella) routine vaccinations is approaching. If you are eligible and wish to receive the vaccination, please make an appointment with a medical institution early and receive the vaccination within the deadline.

Eligible: Children in the year prior to entering elementary school (born April 2, 2019 - April 1, 2020)

Deadline: Tuesday, March 31st Vaccination

Location: Designated

## ► Lighting Children's Future Up!!

Food Allergy Policy at nursery schools 保育所の食物アレルギー対応

In nursery schools, they provide a food and nutrition education for the children and manage to use seasonal ingredients in their lunch menu.

Our Nursery schools' lunch program implements a food allergy policy based on "complete elimination" as a fundamental safety measure, providing elimination diets and alternative meals.

When an "elimination diet" is required, we follow this process as below:

- ① Submission of documentation such as a "Lifestyle Management Guidance Form" based on a doctor's diagnosis
- ② Conducting a consultation with childcare staff and nutritionists
- ③ Determining the facility's response

This ensures children with food allergies can safely enjoy their school lunches.

### Disaster Prevention Tips Vol. 5

Collecting information / checking the safety during the emergency

Getting the accurate information quicker when disaster occurs enables you to save your lives. Make sure how to get information and how to contact with your family in advance so you won't get panic when it happens.

#### ● 災害時の情報収集 How to get information during the emergency

TV, radio, or weather forecast/ disaster prevention app. : Check the emergency alert broadcasted by news media.

Official websites ran by public organization :

Getting the highly reliable information through Okinawa City or Japan Meteorological Agency(気象庁)

Disaster prevention administrative radio :

When the radio does not sound clear, you can call the number below to confirm the announcement. [TEL:0120-0978-99](tel:0120-0978-99)

Okinawa City Official LINE/Mail magazine :

Please register yourself in advance so you can receive the information through push notifications.

#### ● 家族等との安否確認 Checking the safety of family members, etc.

Phone lines will become very hard to get connected during the emergency. Knowing the services which connectable during the emergency is highly recommended.

Disaster Emergency Message Dial (171) :

Dial "171", follow the guidance and record and replay if you are okay or not.

Disaster Message Board (Web171) :

You can register your safety situation by text through your smart phone or PC.

#### 【Important Tip】

Decide a "Key phone number" in advance and share it with your family members.
