National Pension System ~ Please submit a notification if the following applies to you~

All registered residents of Japan between the ages of 20 and 60 must be enrolled in Japan's National Pension System.

XYou must notify your category at the time of enrollment, as well as in the following situations:

Please note that if you fail to notify, your pension annuity may be reduced.

There are three categories of insured persons under this system.

©Category 1 Insured Persons: People who are self-employed, agricultural and fishery employees and their spouses, and students who are 20 years old and older.

©Category 2 Insured Persons: People who are covered by employees' pension insurance or mutual aid society.

Category 3 Insured Persons: People who are a dependant spouse of a Category 2 insured person.
