June is the payment deadline for the following taxes:

Residential Tax (1st term)/ Long-term Care Insurance Premium (1st term). If you use automatic bank transfers, payments will be withdrawn on June 30th. Make sure you have enough money in your bank account the day before.

► Mumps Vaccination Expenses Ful-

ly Covered!

Okinawa City currently provides vaccinations for mumps under the following conditions:

Vaccination Period:

Until March 31, 2018

Eligibility: The child must be a year old and a registered resident of Okinawa City (Notification will be mailed to the eligible children).

Number of vaccination: Once **Location:** Designated medical facility (appointment required).

*A List of facilities are enclosed in the notification.

*Please make sure you bring your residence card to the medical facility for vaccination.

Fee: FREE

*However, this is limited to vaccinations received at a designated medical facility (appointment required) during the given vaccination period.

IMPORTANT! Receive a thorough explanation from your doctor regarding each vaccination. Only upon your understanding and consent should you request to have your child vaccinated. *Medical history forms are provided at each designated medical facility.

*Vaccination types and schedules in foreign countries (including military bases) may differ. Please come to the service window with your mother-child health record book to confirm your child's vaccination history.

► Financial Aid Project for Higher Skills Training

(高等職業訓練促進給付金)

This program supports single parent households and will provide financial aid for a certain period to approved applicants who will be studying at a training institution for more than a year to acquire advantageous licenses to find employment (e.g. nurse, child care provider, physical therapist, work therapist, beautician, cook etc.).

Eligibility: Single parents who are currently living in Okinawa City and also satisfy all the requirements listed below:

- 1 You are a recipient of Child Rearing Allowance for Single Parents, or your amount of income meets the standard requirement to receive an allowance.
- ② You have been studying at a training institution for more than a year and are expected to acquire some form of qualification on the training.
- 3 It is recognized that you are having difficulty balancing work, child-raising and your training.
- 4 You have never received this benefit before.
- (5) You are not currently receiving benefits similar to this one.
- *All the applications will be reviewed to receive the benefit. Please visit us for consultation if you are already under training or will start training.

► Proof of Income for the FY 2017 (Income in 2016)

Proof of income (for 2016) can be issued after June 1, 2017 (Thu).

Applicable to: Those who have been living in Okinawa City as a registered resident as of January 1, 2017 up to present and have filed their income by the deadline, and those who have become a dependant.

Who can request proof of income: You or someone from the same household can request proof of income.

Required documents: Your driver's license, health insurance certificate, residence card, passport or other documents.

XA Power of Attorney will be required for requests submitted by those who are not of the same household.

▶ Do Not Miss the Payment Due Date for National Pension Premium Payment

The monthly amount of national pension premium between April 2017 and March 2018: **¥16,490**.

How to Pay:

Pay out with the payment slip sent by Japan Pension Service at any banking facility, post office, or convenience store. You can also pay by credit card, through the internet, or credit transfer. You can also pay by account transfer so payments are not late.

If you miss the due date:

JPS sends the notice of early payment by mail. However, if tax payers still leave it unpaid after the due date, they will get charged overdue tax and can even get their property distrained. Please make sure to pay before the due date.

If it is difficult to pay:

If you have difficulty paying due to financial reasons, you can apply for exemption or ex-

tension of payment. Please consult the National Pension Section at the Okinawa City Hall or Koza Pension Office. **Contact:**

► Jido Teate Genkyo Todoke Present Circumstance Report for Child Benefits

If you are presently (as of June 1, 2017) receiving child benefits in Okinawa City, you must submit a *genkyo todoke* (a notification reporting your present circumstances). If you do not submit this notification, your benefits will be suspended (for payment terms after October 2017).

Notification forms will be sent mid-June. Submission dates have been scheduled as crowding during this period is expected. If you are unable to visit the Children's Welfare Division on the date scheduled for your district, you can submit the notification anytime within the submission period.

Persons permitted to submit the notification are limited to you, your spouse, or a family member of the same household.

Submission Period: June 12 (Mon)~ 30 (Fri) (Excluding weekends and June 23, a public holiday on Okinawa)

Submission Hours: 8:30~ 17:15 (including lunch hour, 12:00~ 13:00)

Location: Okinawa City Hall *Kodomo Katei Ka* (Children's Welfare Division) 2F

What to Bring:

- (1) The notification form sent to you
- (2) The *inkan* (personal seal) of the person submitting the form.
- (3) Copies of the recipient's (the bank account holder's), and each child's health insurance certificates (unnecessary for national health insurance holders)
- (4) Your FY 2017 income certificate for Child Benefit (only needed if you moved into Okinawa City after January 2, 2017)
- (5) A copy of your child's residence record (juminhyo-tohon) (Only required for those who are separated from, but have custody over, children under age 18 who live outside of Okinawa City.)

XIf you are a foreign resident, bring your residence card. Other necessary documents will vary with each household. Please confirm with
