Residential Tax (1st term)/ Long-term Care Insurance Premium (1st term). If you use automatic bank transfers, payments will be withdrawn on July 2nd. Make sure you have enough money in your bank account the day before.

# Mumps Vaccination Expenses Fully Covered!

Okinawa City currently provides vaccinations for mumps under the following conditions: Vaccination Peri-



Until March 31, 2019

**Eligibility**: The child must be a year old and a registered resident of Okinawa City (Notification will be mailed to the eligible children).

#### Number of vaccination: Once

**Location:** Designated medical facility (appointment required).

\*A List of facilities are enclosed in the notification.

\*Please make sure you bring your residence card to the medical facility for vaccination.

#### Fee: FREE

\*However, this is limited to vaccinations received at a designated medical facility (appointment required) during the given vaccination period.

**IMPORTANT!** Receive a thorough explanation from your doctor regarding each vaccination. Only upon your understanding and consent should you request to have your child vaccinated.

\*Medical history forms are provided at each designated medical facility. \*Vaccination types and schedules in foreign countries (including military bases) may differ. Please come to the service window with your motherchild health record book to confirm your child's vaccination history.

# Okinawa City Provides Support Programs for Single Parents

#### **Independence Support Program for Single Parents**

Programs are developed for individual cases and vocational support in cooperation with Hellowork (Employment agency ) are provided to support Single Parent Child Rearing Allowance beneficiaries.

#### Educational Training and Self-Reliance Support Benefit

This program assists single parents by providing support for eligible vocational training/certificate course expenses. \*Introducing to the training facility is not included.

#### **Financial Aid Project for Higher Skills Training**

This program will provide financial aid for a certain period to approved applicants who will be studying at a training institution for more than a year to acquire advantageous licenses to find employment (e.g. nurse or child care provider). \*Introducing to the training facility is not included.



#### **Daily Living Support Program**

When single parents are in need of house chores or child care for some reasons, daily living supporter will be sent to their house to support cooking, other personal care or child care. It needs an advanced application to use this service.

#### Welfare Funds Loan for Single Parents (Widows)

There are several loan systems to contribute to financial independence and lifestyle stability of single parents and widows, and development of child welfare.

#### Proof of Income for the FY 2018 (Income in 2017)

Proof of income (for 2017) can be issued after <u>June 1, 2018 (Fri)</u>. **Applicable to:** Those who have been living in Okinawa City as a registered resident as of January 1, 2018 up to present and have filed their income by the deadline, and those who have become a dependent.

Who can request proof of income: You or someone from the same household can request proof of income.

**Required documents:** Your driver's license, health insurance certificate, residence card, passport or other documents.

XA Power of Attorney will be required for requests submitted by those who are not of the same household.

# ► Do Not Miss the Payment Due Date for National Pension Premium Payment

The monthly amount of national pension premium between April 2018 and March 2019: <u>¥16,340.</u>

#### How to Pay:

Pay out with the payment slip sent by Japan Pension Service at any banking facility, post office, or convenience store. You can also pay by credit card, through the internet, or credit transfer. You can also pay by account transfer so payments are not late.

#### If it is difficult to pay:

If you have difficulty paying due to financial reasons, you can apply for exemption or extension of payment. Please consult the National Pension Section at the Okinawa City Hall or Koza Pension Office.

#### ► Jido Teate Genkyo Todoke Present Circumstance Report for Child Benefits

If you are presently (as of June 1, 2018) receiving child benefits in Okinawa City, you must submit a *genkyo todoke* (a notification reporting your present circumstances). If you do not submit this notification, your benefits will be suspended (for payment terms after October 2018).

Submission dates have been scheduled as crowding during this period is expected. If you are unable to visit the Children's Welfare Division on the date scheduled for your district, you can submit the notification anytime within the submission period.

Persons permitted to submit the notification are limited to you, your spouse, or a family member of the same household.

Submission Period: June 11 (Mon)~ 29 (Fri) (Excluding Saturdays and Sundays) Submission Hours: 8:30~ 17:15

(including lunch hour, 12:00~13:00) Location: Okinawa City Hall Kodomo Katei Ka

#### What to Bring:

- (1) The notification form sent to you (form will be mailed by middle of June)
- (2) The *inkan* (personal seal) of the person submitting the form.
- (3) A copy of the recipient (the bank account holder's), and each child's health insurance certificates (unnecessary for national health insurance holders)
- (4) Your FY 2018 income certificate for Child Benefit (only needed if you moved into Okinawa City after January 2, 2018)

(5) A copy of your child's residence record (*juminhyo-tohon*) (only required for those who are separated from, but have custody over, children under age 18 who live outside of Okinawa City.)

XIf you are a foreign resident, bring your residence card. Other necessary documents will vary with each household. Please confirm with *Kodomo Katei Ka* (Children's Welfare Division) in advance.

When a Typhoon (*Taifu*-台風) Hits...

As a typhoon develops, a "Storm Zone" (*Bofu-iki* 暴風域) with winds exceeding <u>25m/s</u>, and a "Storm Alert" (*Bofu keiho* 暴風警報) will be announced if buildings and transportation systems are in danger of severe disaster and damages. Typhoons also affect public service schedules (please listen to typhoon updates on the TV/radio):

The city hall will close when public buses and monorails stop.

**Garbage collection** will run as usual if public buses are operating as of <u>8am</u>. However, if buses stop, garbage collection will also stop. If buses do not start by noon, garbage collection will be cancelled for the day. Please wait for the next collection day.

**Elementary/Junior High Schools** will be closed while on <u>"Storm Alert"</u>. Here is the schedule to follow when the alert is cancelled by:

<u>6:30am</u> $\rightarrow$ school by 8:15am (lunch provided). <u>7am</u> $\rightarrow$ school by 9am (snack provided).

<u>7-9am</u>→school by 10am \*classes only in the morning (no lunch).

<u>9-12 noon</u> $\rightarrow$ school by 1:30pm (no lunch).

<u>Cancelled at 12 noon or later</u>  $\rightarrow$  No school. You are responsible for safety precautions when going to and leaving school. Please contact your school
