June is the payment deadline for the following taxes:

Residential Tax (1st term)/ Long-term Care Insurance Premium (1st term). If you use automatic bank transfers, payments will be withdrawn on June 30. Make sure you have enough money in your bank account the day before.

► COVID-19 Self-reliance Support Benefit 生活困窮者自立支援金

If a household is unable to use the Special Emergency Small Loans provided by the Social Welfare Council (i.e., those with the borrowing amount has reached the limit or their re-lending request has been disapproved) and they meets the requirements, support money will be provided per month (for three months).

In addition, those who have received the benefit for three months and also meet certain requirements can receive it again (only once).

-Revised Child Care and Family Care Leave Law

The Child Care and Family Care Leave Law has been revised to improve the environment to make it easier to take child care leave, and to require employers to inform and confirm the intension against individual employees. Also the establishment of the "Dads' Child Care Leave Law" will come into effect sequentially from April 1, 2022. It is necessary to create an environment that facilitates childcare leave.

-Law for the Promotion of Women's Advancement

The obligation to formulate and submit a general business owner action plan and the obligation to disclose information on the success of women's activities in their company will be extended to companies with 101 or more full-time employees. Effective date: April 1, 2022

Okinawa City Additional Meal Support Benefit for Supplemental Meals (<u>Private Kindergartens</u>)

If you satisfy any of the requirements for eligibility, submit the application form before the closing date.

Eligibility: A child who is receiving nursery school tuition benefit and also satisfy either ① **or** ② given below:

①The household with the amount of per income levy of resident tax in FY 2022 shows **under 77,101 yen**

(An annual income of the household is under 3,600,000 yen).

②If you have a child that hasn't finished third grade yet and you count them as your first child, then your **third child and later** are eligible.

*Eligibility for the payment from April to August 2022 will be based on the tax amount for the fiscal year 2021, and those for the period from September 2022 to March 2023 will be based on the tax amount for the fiscal year 2022.

Coverage of the Benefit: Supplemental meal fees out of the school lunch fees you paid to the kindergarten from April, 2022 through March, 2023 will be covered.

* Even if you moved during the period, you may be eligible to apply for the same amount of time you resided in Okinawa City.

Benefit Amount: Up to 4,500 yen per child (Exceptions: staple foods (like bread or rice) and foods provided during extended child care hours.)

Application Documents: Issued at each kindergarten

Application Deadline: From the month you paid the lunch fee in FY 2021 and until March 31 (Fri), 2023

▶ Proof of Income for the FY 2022 (Income in 2021)

Proof of income (for 2021) can be issued after June 1, 2022 (Wed) at Property Tax Division (2F).

Applicable to: Those who have been living in Okinawa City as a registered resident as of January 1, 2022 up to present and have filed their income by the deadline, and those who have become a dependent.

Who can request proof of income: You or someone from the same household can request proof of income.

Required documents: Your "my number card", driver's license, health insurance certificate, resident card, passport or other documents to proof your identification

*A Power of Attorney will be required for requests submitted by those who are not of the same household.

**If you have your "my number card" and you are not a dependent, you can get your income certificate and also income taxation certificate issued at convenience stores. Issuance at convenience stores will available after June 1(Wed) 13:00.

***If you move out of the city, you will not be able to receive the certificate at convenience stores.

► Child Allowance (Jido Teate) System Has Been Changed in The Following Items

Child allowance system has been changed in the following items:

1. The maximum amount of income for the provision of special benefits will be set. → Some people may not be eligible for special benefits depending on their income. 2. In principle, the annual status report submitted in June will no longer be required.

If you fall under any of the following five categories, you are required to continue to submit a current status report

- -Those whose registration of residence is different from Okinawa City due to spousal violence, etc.
- -Those who do not have a family register or resident registration for a child eligible for child allowance
- -Those who are in divorce proceedings and separated from their spouse.
- -Guardianships of minors that are legal entities, institutional or other beneficiaries
- -Others who have been announced by Okinawa City to submit

▶ The 4th Dose Vaccination For COVID-19 Will Start

On April 27, 2022, a subcommittee of the Ministry of Health, Labor and Welfare (MHLW) formulated a policy on who should receive the fourth dose of COVID-19 vaccine.

Who is Eligible? (As of beginning of May, 2022)

- 1 Those who are age of 60 or above.
- 2 Those who are between the ages of 18 and 59 with underlying medical conditions.

And they all must be at least 5 months after completion of the third vaccination.

Vaccine Used: Either Pfizer or Moderna (scheduled)

Vaccination tickets will be sent to those 60 years of age and older. Delivery of inoculation tickets: Late June (scheduled)

If you have an underlying medical condition and wish to have your 4th vaccination ticket sent out, please contact the call center below.

After that, vaccination tickets will be sent out sequentially to those who have newly reached the age of 60.

When Can I Get Vaccinated?

If you took the 3rd dose in: You can take the 4th dose after:

Jan, 2022 Jun, 2022 Feb. 2022 Jul, 2022

Updates for the 4th vaccination will be available on the city's official website sequentially. The 1st to 3rd vaccinations and those for children (5 to 11 years old) will also continue to be administered.

► Your Pension Benefits: The "Additional Pension" System

If you are a category 1 insured person or are voluntarily enrolled in the pension system, you can increase the amount of benefits you will receive by paying ¥400/month in addition to the fixed monthly insurance premium amount (¥16,590 as of the fiscal year 2022).

The additional annual pension amount you will receive will be ¥200 multiplied by the number of months you pay for the additional amount.

Example: You pay the additional ¥400/month for 10 years (120 months). The additional amount you will pay is ¥48,000 (¥400x 10 Years [120 months]). When you begin to receive your elderly pension benefits, the additional amount you will receive in one year will be ¥24,000 (¥200x 10 Years [120 months]). In other words, the additional premium you paid over a span of 10 years will come back to you in just 2 years, and you will only profit from the rest after that!

*The ¥400 must be paid in addition to your monthly premium.

*If you are enrolled to "National Pension Fund", or are exempted from the pension premium payment, the Additional Pension System doesn't apply to you.

*You will start paying the additional pension amount from the month you applied (the payment deadline will be the end of the following month).

*You can pay overdue payments within two years after the due date.
