

Administrative Announcements

Please Note:

May is the payment period for Light Vehicle Tax.

If you use automatic bank transfers, payments will be withdrawn on May 31. Make sure you have enough money in your bank account the day before.



If you live in Okinawa City and wish to receive this vaccination, you can receive it for a subsidized rate. **<u>**Please note!</u>** If you have already received this **pneumococcal vaccine (23-Valent)**, you will not be eligible to receive it at the subsidized rate.



Vaccination Period:

Until March 31, 2020 (Tuesday)

Where you can get vaccinated: Any designated medical facility. (Fees for vaccinations received at other facilities will not be subsidized.) Please make sure you bring your resident card.

Vaccination Fee: Covered by government. *Those who are between 60 and 64 years old with heart, kidney, respiratory function or HIV related immunity disorder (equivalent to physical disability level 1) are also eligible to this vaccination.

► The 5th Term Antibody Test And Regular Vaccination For Rubella

With the epidemic of rubella, the rubella antibody test at the medical facilities and regular vaccination as needed has been decided to be offered as an additional provision to males who haven't received MR vaccination in the past.

*You cannot receive vaccination without taking antibody test.

► Mumps Vaccination Covered By Government

As an administrative action, government covers the full amount for the mumps vaccination .

*This vaccination is only available for when parents wish to receive it with understanding of the thorough explanation from the doctor.

► Okinawa City Preparatory Support Project

This project provide supports for the students to attend designated private preparatory school for free.

Eligibility: 3rd graders of Junior High

School with single parent household under the public assistance or in an equivalent in-need of support. <u>Up to</u> 80 students.

► Subsidy For The Revaccination After Bone-Marrow Implant etc.

This will subsidize the cost of revaccination when you have bone-marrow implant after getting regu-

lar vaccination, and the doctor determines that the regular vaccination may not be effective after the implant. Subsidy is available until March 31 (Tue),2020

*Make sure you apply in advance to get the subsidy. Please contact below for eligibility and what you need for the application. Please come to the service window in advance with your residence card and your vaccination history.

► Subsidies For Home Renovation Construction

Conditions:

- -The total construction cost must be more than ¥200,000.
- -Construction must be able to be completed and reported no later than the end of February 2020.
- * Construction that has been already completed or started is not eligible for the subsidy. Please make sure you apply before the construction starts

Eligible Construction/ Subsidy Rate (%)/ Limit Amount (¥)

Housing reform- 20%/¥200,000

Barrier-free construction/Energy saving construction-25%/¥250.000

Brick walls removal -¥200,000 *This refers to brick walls which in a school zone, and higher than 1.2m.

► Light-vehicle Road Tax Exemption For Disability Certificate Holders

This system applies to the following people:

- · Shintai-shogaisha-techo (physical disability certificate), ryoiku techo (intellectual disability certificate), seishin-shogaisha-hoken-fukushi-techo (psychiatric disability certificate) or sensho-byosha-techo (war injury and illness certificate) holders.
- Certificate holders and their family members within the same household.
- · Certificate holders and their family members who may not live within the same household, but share living expenses.*
- · Those who give constant care for a disabled person who lives alone.*
- *This only applies if you are able to get a *seikei-doitsu-shomeisho* (proof of shared livelihood expenses) or *joji-kaigo-shomeisho* (proof of continuous nursing care) issued by the Welfare Office Director if the certificate holder and driver are from separate households.
- Documents needed for application:
- **1.** The applicable certificate (physical, learning, intellectual mental disability, or war injury and illness certificate) as of April 1st .
- 2. Vehicle inspection certificate (shaken sho)
- 3. Driver's license of the driver
- 4. Inkan
- 5. Tax notification form
- 6. Individual Number (My Number) notification card or your Individual Number Card
- *Those who are eligible for this system must apply at the **Resident's Tax Division** service window by May 31 (Friday).

►The FY 2019 Rabies Vaccination Schedule

Vaccination FEE: ¥3,400 (Vaccine: ¥2,850 + Certificate: ¥550)

This event is only available for all dogs that live in Okinawa city (must live off base) as well as dogs owned by US SOFA status residents in Okinawa City.

(この狂犬病予防接種は沖縄市に住むすべての犬が対象になります。USSOFA保持者の犬も対象になります。ただし、基地内で犬 を飼育している場合は対象外です。)

- *There is a registration fee of ¥3,000 if your dog has not been registered.
- -You will need to get your dog's tag re-issued (¥1,600) if you have lost it.
- -Depending on your dog's condition on the day of getting the shot, they may not be able to get vaccinated. You can also get them vaccinated at any veterinary hospital. Please contact the hospital about costs and other details.
- -Someone who can keep your dog under control should bring them to the vaccination site. Make sure your dog's collar is on tight and keep them on a short leash. Put a muzzle on them if they tend to bite.
- -Please clean up after your dog if they make a mess.
- -Avoid giving your dog a bath or strenuous exercise after the vaccination.
- -There are some schedule change on *the bold typed location & dates.

Payments are accepted in YEN ONLY.

*Vaccination services will be provided in **JAPANESE ONLY**. Please bring your own interpreter if you need one.
