The COVID-19 Spring Vaccine for the spring season will begin on May 8th MON_

The COVID-19 Spring Vaccination schedule is as follows. Additional Omicron strain-compatible vaccines for ages up to 12 will end on May 7th (Sun).

From May 8 (Mon) to August 31 (Thu) Eligibility: Requires completion of both the first and second vaccinations, with 3 months passed since the last vaccination, and meeting the following conditions $(1)\sim(3)$.

①Individuals age 65 and older.

2 Those who have been deemed eligible by their doctor due to with high risk of underlying disease and other serious illness.

3 Medical staff working at medical institutions and elderly care facilities.

▶ Please Note:

May is the payment period for Light Vehicle Tax.

If you use automatic bank transfers, payments will be withdrawn on May 31(Wed).

Make sure you have enough money in your bank account the day before.



Vaccination Fee: ¥3,400 (Vaccine: **¥2,850** + Certificate: **¥550**)

- *Please pay exact amount to save time avoid dealing with change.
- -There is a registration fee of (¥3,000) if your dog has not been registered.
- -You will need to get your dog's tag re-issued (¥1,600) if you have lost it.
- -Depending on your dog's condition on the day of getting the shot, they may not be able to get vaccinated. You can also get them vaccinated at any veterinary hospital. Please contact the hospital about costs and other details.
- -Avoid giving your dog a bath or strenuous exercise after the vaccination.
- -The vaccination is also mandatory for all dogs living off base. Payments are accepted in **YEN ONLY**.
- *Vaccination services will be provided in **JAPANESE ONLY**. Please bring your own interpreter if you need one.

► Light Vehicle Road Tax Exemption For Disability Certificate Holders

This system applies to the following people:

- · Physical Disability Certificate (*Shintai-shogaisha-techo*), Intellectual Disability Certificate (*ryoiku techo*), Psychiatric Disability Certificate (*seishin-shogaisha-hoken-fukushi-techo*) or War Injury And Illness Certificate (*sensho-byosha-techo*) holders. *
- · Certificate holders and their family members within the same household.*
- · Certificate holders and their family members who may not live within the same household, but share living expenses.*
- · Those who give constant care for a disabled person who lives alone.* This only applies if you are able to get a Proof of Shared Livelihood Expenses (*seikei-doitsu-shomeisho*) or Proof of Continuous Nursing Care (*joji-kaigo-shomeisho*) issued by the Welfare Office Director if the certificate holder and driver are from separate households.


Those who are eligible for this system must apply at the **Resident's Tax Division** service window by May 31 (Wed).

Documents needed for application:

1. Certificate (physical, learning, intellectual mental disability, or war injury and illness certificate) which is valid as of <u>April 1st</u>. 2. Vehicle inspection certificate (*shaken sho*) 3. Driver's license of the driver 4. Tax notification form 5. Applicant's ID (Resident card etc.)

You will be subject to late fees (based on regulations) and accruing over-due payments if you fail to pay your elderly health insurance premiums, and when it comes time to renew your insurance certificate (around August every year), you may only be issued a temporary one.

Please do not forget to pay your elderly health insurance premiums.

If you have not been vaccinated and would like to receive the 9-valent vaccine, please contact us using the contact information below.

Those who have already received the prescribed number of doses of other HPV vaccines are not eligible to receive the 9-valent vaccine.

2 Women who were born between April 2,1997 to April 1. 2007 are eligible.

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► Have You Applied For The Medical Expense Subsidy For People (Children) With Severe Mental And Physical Disabilities?

Those who hold a certificate of physical disability or intellectual disability and the following conditions apply are eligible to receive subsidies for medical expenses which accrued after they had their disability certified. (Available between a month after and within a year of payment).

Eligibility:

- -Okinawa City residents.
- -Those who are insured by the government medical insurance and hold one of the following certificates:
 - 1. Physical disability certificate (1st or 2nd degree).
 - 2. Intellectual disability certificate (A1 or A2)
 - 3. Both physical disability (3rd degree) and intellectual disability (B1).
- *If the income of the subsidy beneficiary and the person financially responsible exceeds a certain amount, they will not be eligible to receive subsidies.
- *Those who are receiving public assistance are not eligible. -Applicant's health insurance card
- *If the beneficiary is eligible for Medical Care Support for Bank account book (with applicant's name) Children as an outpatient, they will not be eligible.

- -If the application is submitted by proxy, need ID of the proxy
- *If applicant moved in from outside of Okinawa City, they need to submit their income tax certificate.
