In order to ensure tax <u>fairness and justice</u>, November and December have been designated as <u>months for</u> <u>strengthening the collection of prefectural, municipal, and township taxes</u>, and we are working together to enhance collection measures.

For delinquent borrowers who have failed to pay after receiving notice from Okinawa City, we are working to liquidate their delinquencies, including the seizure of savings, wages, real estate, and other assets. If you have not yet finished your payments, please make your payment as soon as possible.

If you are unable to pay your taxes on time due to unavoidable circumstances such as business closure, unemployment, or illness, please contact the Tax Collection Division as soon as possible.

► Flu (Influenza) Vaccination & Corona Virus Regular Vaccination.

インフルエンザ・新型コロナワクチン定期予防接種 Okinawa City mailed a notification postcard to eligible residents in the middle of September.

Eligibility: Residents who are over 65 years old & 60 to 64 years old with server disorder of heart, kidney, respiration organ, or immunization function caused by HIV (equivalent to level 1 of physical disability certificate).

Eligible Period:

October 1 (Tue) - February 28 (Fri), 2025

Influenza Vaccination is free.

Corona Virus Vaccination costs ¥3,000.— . Influenza coverage is available only one time at designated medical facilities.

Abolition of health insurance card 健康保険被保険者証の廃止

Due to the amendment of the law, the system has been changed to one where medical examinations are conducted using your *My Number Card*, which is registered for the use of an insurance card.


Your current insurance card will be discontinued on December 2nd 2024.

After this date, new or reissued insurance cards will no longer be issued.

After December 2nd 2024

Person who fall under any of the following categories.

- ①Newly Qualified Persons (Those who move in, withdraw from social insurance, abolish public assistance or turn 75 years old and are in the late- stage seniors category)
- **②Those who have lost their insured person's card and need to have it reissued**
- ③People who make changes to their insured card.(e.g. Address or rate changes)
- **Those who fall under the category of elderly beneficiaries.** (Over 70 years old)




You will receive Notifications of Qualifications. 資格情報のお知らせを交付.
