

Administrative Announcements

➤ Please Note:

October is the payment deadline for the following taxes:

Resident tax (3rd term)/ Long-term care insurance premium (5th term)/ National health insurance premium (4th term)/ Medical care for the elderly insurance premium (4th term).

If you use automatic bank transfers, payments will be withdrawn on October 31. Make sure you have enough money in your bank account the day before.

► Payment Flow for Kindergarten & Nursery School Tuition Coverage

If you have applied for the tuition coverage service, please read below for payment flow:

- **①In-kind coverage:** You don't have to pay the tuition to the school. Payment will be claimed to the city hall by your school.
- **②Reimbursement:** You pay the tuition to school first and you also have to apply for reimbursement at the city hall.
- ♦Public/Government-approved Nursery Schools: # ①
- ♦ Certified Childcare Institution: # ① for education, # ② for extended daycare
- ♦ Private Schools: Ask the school directly about payment.

► Subsidy for the Purchase of Hearing Aid for Kids

This subsidy will cover a part of the expense of hearing aids for children who are not eligible for a disability certificate, but suffer from a mild degree of hearing disability.

Eligibility

Okinawa City citizen who satisfy all the following conditions:

Children under age 18 at the time of application./Hearing levels of both ears show over 30 and under 70 decibel, making them not eligible for a disability certificate./Their hearing loss must be diagnosed by a designated doctor, and determined that a hearing aid should be effective for the acquisition of language.

- *Applicants are <u>not eligible</u> if any of their household members are subject to more than ¥460,000 for resident tax per income levy, or if they are eligible for another benefit.
- *The subsidy is <u>not applicable</u> if you have already receive benefits under another law.
- *The subsidy is <u>not applicable</u> if you have already bought a hearing aid. Please consult before applying.

Barrier-free construction/Energy saving construction-25%/up to ¥250,000 Brick walls removal –Up to ¥200,000

► Flu Vaccination for **Those Who are 65 Years Old and Over**

If you are a resident of Okinawa City and at least 65 years old, you can receive the flu vaccination for free (fees will be covered by the government). You will receive a notification in the mail if you are eligible.

Vaccination Period:

October 1(Tue), 2019

~ February 29(Sat), 2020

Where you can get vaccinated/ Any designated medical facility. (There is a list organizations, companies, all households, etc.) of designated medical facilities within Okinawa City included in the mailed notification. Please contact the division in charge for questions about designated medical facilities outside of Okinawa City.)

Vaccination Fee/ Free (covered by the government)

[Important] You can only receive the free vaccination once. You have to pay the fee out of your pocket after the second time.

Please make sure you have your resident card when you receive a vaccination.

► FY 2019 Okinawa City Earthquake & Tsunami Evacuation Drill (held simultaneously prefecture-wide)

In order to improve the disaster management system, an evacuation drill will be held all throughout Okinawa Prefecture to educate citizens on earthquake and tsunami disaster preparedness and verify tsunami evacuation plans.

- When: November 5 (Tue) 10:00~11:30
- Districts: All cities and their districts (All districts of Okinawa Prefecture)
- Eligible Participants: All citizens are subject to participate in the drill (schools, voluntary disaster management
- *Start/end of drill will be notified through Okinawa City Community wireless system
- Drill Outline: 10:00 AM- Assume that an earthquake has hit and conduct earthquake evacuation drill. 10:03 AM-Assume that a giant tsunami warning has been announced and conduct tsunami evacuation drill (citizens who live in low-lying areas should evacuate to higher ground)

*An emergency announcement through Area Mail will be sent out by the prefecture.

11:30 AM-Announcement for completion of drill.
