► COVID-19 Okinawa Prefecture **Provides Drive-through PCR Test** Starting September 1!

Okinawa Prefecture has opened a drivethrough PCR testing site in the central area to make it easier for people who have come into close contact with the virus to get tested. You will be asked to take a saliva sample by yourself while in the car.

You can make a reservation online from 9:30 a.m. on the day of your visit, but only for same -day appointments.

PCR Test Site: Okinawa Comprehensive Athletic Park (5-3-1 Hiyagon, Okinawa City) Eligibility: People who have been in contact with a positive person

How to Make a Reservation: Only by online from 9:30 a.m. on the day of your visit (only for same-day appointments).

Information on The Project to Prevent The Spread of Household Infections

In order to prevent the spread of the new coronavirus infection, this program supports the cost of accommodation for family members who live with a close-contact person, or when the close-contact person spends time away from the family. However, there is a limit.

*Close-contact person and their family members have to be negative to corona virus at PCR test.

Period of use: Up to 14 days

Or until the end of the health observation period for the person in closecontact or his/her family.

Accommodations: Hotel and other lodging facilities in Okinawa City. *The name and location will be provided at the time of application. Amount of support: Up to 5,000 yen per person per night

*If the cost of accommodation is less than 5000 yen per night, the actual cost of accommodation will be supported.

Support for Patients Receiving Home Treatment for COVID-19

Okinawa City will provide daily necessities and other supplies to those who have tested positive for the new coronavirus infection and are recuperating at home, but are unable to receive support from their relatives.

You can apply to the city hall by phone or email, and the necessary supplies will be sent to your home.

Eligibility: People who are Okinawa city citizens, have difficulty receiving support from their relatives, etc., and meet one of the following criteria. (1) People who have tested positive for COVID-19 and are receiving home treatment or on home standby. (2) The person who tested positive has family members living with them, but it is difficult to support them because the family members also in need of nursing care, etc.

Daily necessities and other goods necessary for daily life are provided on a one-time basis for each household with positive residents. How to Apply/ Receive the Goods: You can apply to the city hall by

If you use automatic bank transfers, payments will be withdrawn on <u>November 1</u>. Make sure you have enough money in your bank account the day before.

Special Livelihood Support Benefits for Low-income Households

Tieshotoku no Kosodate Seitai Seikatsu Shien Tokubetsu Kyufu Kin 低所得の 子育て世帯生活支援特別給付金

With the prolonged impact of the COVID-19, benefits will be provided to low-income child-raising households to support their daily lives based on their actual circumstances.

*Please note that those who have already received the same benefit for single parent household are not eligible for this benefit.

1. Eligibility for Beneficially : Applicants must fall into the following categories (1) to (3):

(1) Those who only have children born between April 2, 2003 and April 1, 2006 and are non-taxable in FY 2021 (on per capita basis) household.

(2) Those who are civil servant and received Child Allowance, and are non-taxable in FY 2021 (on per capita basis) household.

(3) Those household who do NOT apply to (1) and (2) and their finances have suddenly changed due to the impact of the COVID-19, and whose income is at the same level as those who are non-taxable in FY 2021(on per capita basis) household.

2. Benefit Amount: 50,000 yen per child

3. How to Process: Applications are required.

If you meet the conditions below, you will be eligible for benefits at any time in the future:

(1) Those who are taking care of a child born between April 1, 2021 and February 28, 2022, and who are exempted from paying resident tax (per capita) for the FY 2021.

⁽²⁾Those who are taking care of a child who became eligible for Special Child Rearing Allowance in or after May 2011, and who are exempt from resident tax (per capita) for the FY 2021.

Subsidies For The Use of Non-approved Childcare Facilities For Single-parent Families, etc.

Subsidizes the fees for single-parent families to use non-approved childcare facilities (Mothers or fathers of single-parent families who have registered their address in Okinawa City and meet all three of the following requirements):

① Parents or guardians who meet the eligibility requirements for the Child Rearing Allowance for Single Parent and the Medical Care Support for Children Program for Single Parents.② Parents or guardians of the child who has been qualified for payment. ③ The guardian of the children on waiting lists due to the capacity is full in approved nursery schools.

Additional Meal Support Benefit for Supplemental Meals (Private Kindergartens)

The supplemental meals out of the school lunch fees you paid to the kindergarten will be covered.

Eligibility: The child who is registered as a Okinawa City citizen and receiving nursery school tuition benefit and also satisfy either ① or ② given below: ①The household with the amount of per income levy of resident tax in previous fiscal year shows under 77,101 yen

(2) If you have a child that hasn't finished third grade yet and you count them as your first child, then your third child and later are eligible .

► Have You Applied For The "Pensioner Support Benefits"?

If you are living off a pension, additional financial support ("Pensioner Support Benefits") will be given if you earn less than a certain amount. <u>You have to apply</u> at pension office to receive this benefit. Eligibility

♦ You are receiving "Old-Age Basic Pension" and also satisfy the following:

✓ You are age 65 or above.

✓ All your household members are non-taxed for resident tax.

✓ Your total annual income including pension and other income does not exceed ¥881,200.

✓ Your income in the previous year does not exceed ¥4,720,000.

How To Apply

(1) If you are already receiving pension benefits and newly receiving the Pension Support Benefits:

The Japan Pension Service (JPS) will send an announcement in the late August to eligible people on how to apply. Fill out the enclosed postcard ("年金生活者支援給付金請求書") and submit it to JPS.

*If the claim procedure is completed by January 4, 2022, you will be able to receive payment back to October 2021.

2 If you started receiving pension :

Visit the Pension Office or Pension Section, Okinawa City Hall to apply for both pension and additional benefit.

Please be aware of suspicious phone calls or invitations from the person pretending to be the Japan Pension Service or the Ministry of Health, Labour and Welfare.

Neither the Japan Pension Service nor the Ministry of Health, Labour and Welfare call you to ask for your family structure, financial institution account numbers or PIN numbers, or ask you for a fee or other money. Cancellation: Rabies Group Shots For Your Dog

The annual rabies group shot at community centers has been cancelled to prevent the spread of the COVID-19. Please make sure your pet receives a rabies shot at the veterinary clinic by the end of the year if at all possible. You can register your dog and receive a rabies vaccination certificate at a hospital affiliated with the Okinawa Veterinary Medical Association. Injections fees, consultation fees, consultations and times vary depending on each hospital.

To avoid congestion in the hospital, please contact each hospital before your visit.

If you have your dog vaccinated at any other hospitals listed below, please bring "Rabies Vaccination Certificate" which was issued at the hospital to Okinawa City Environmental Division and apply for "Rabies Vaccination Tag" as a proof of vaccination.

► Flu Vaccination for The Elderly

If you are a resident of Okinawa City and satisfy the following requirements, you can receive the flu vaccination for free (fees will be covered by the government). You will receive a notification in the mail if you are eligible.

Vaccination Period:

October 1 (Fri) , 2021 ~ February 28 (Mon), 2022

Eligibility: Okinawa City citizen at the time of vaccination and apply to the following: Those who are 65 years old and older Where you can get vaccinated: Any designated medical facility.

Vaccination Fee: Free

(covered by the government)

[Important] You can only receive the free vaccination once . You have to pay the fee out of your pocket after the second time.

Please make sure you have your resident card when you receive a vaccination.
