
Admission for Okinawa Zoo & Museum will be FREE all day and a shuttle bus

► Announcement: Two Allowances If you are eligible, don't forget to apply!





Rinji Fukushi Kyufu Kin (Temporary Welfare Allowance)

Eligibility: Residents of Okinawa City as of January 1, 2016 2つの給付金。 and are also exempted from residential tax for the FY

2016. *Except the following:

- Dependents of a residential tax payer.
- Beneficiaries of public assistance.

Amount of Allowance: ¥3,000 per person (one-time allowance)

Shogai/ Izoku Nenkin Jukyu Sha Muke Kyufu Kin (Allowance for Disability/ Pension for the Bereaved Beneficiaries)

Eligibility: Those that are eligible for the above allowance (Rinji Fukushi Kyufu Kin), and are also receiving Disability Basic Pension (for Degree 1 or 2), or Basic Pension for the Bereaved.

*Those who received the allowance for the elderly is not eligible.

Amount of Allowance: ¥30,000 per person (one-time allowance)

====Application Process=====

The form has been mailed to those eligible mid-August.

Fill out the application form and attach the necessary documents. (If you haven't filed your tax for the FY 2016, please do so before you apply.).

Application Period: August 15, 2016 - January 16, 2017

*Be aware that if you pass the deadline, you won't be able to receive the allowance.

If you satisfy the requirements, the allowance will be deposited into the bank account you filled out on the form. The payment will be in October at the earliest and will be made to those who are approved to be the beneficiary.

► Applications Open for the FY 2017 Development Support Nursery School

Eligibility: Children that are Okinawa City citizens and have physical or mental delays, and considered to require support. They must be in a situation where there

is a lack of child care because of parents' work hours or sickness, and must be able to adjust in a group setting with other children.

The acceptance of entry will be determined by a psychotherapist then consulted by the Okinawa City Development Support Council.

*Nursery school applications must be made after the decision of entry.

School Term: April 1, 2017 (Sat.) – March 31, 2018 (Sat.) Application Period: September 1 (Thu.) –October 7 (Fri.), 2016 Apply at *Hoiku Yochen Ka* (保育幼稚園課 Childcare/ Kindergarten Division)

►-Medical Care Support for Children-The eligible age of outpatient coverage will be expanded.

As of treatment done in October 2016, the outpatient coverage will be expanded from preschool to 3rd grade elementary school (those who were born after April 2, 2007).

What is Medical Support System For Children?

Subsidies that apply to a part of medical treatment expenses you paid, including at the pharmacy and dentist.

Condition of Eligibility

Outpatients:

Treatments done in September 2016: Children who have not yet entered elementary school (until the earliest end of March after they became 6 years-old) are eligible.

Treatments done in October 2016: Children in the 3rd grade (until the earliest end of March after they became 9 years-old) are eligible.

Hospital Stay:

Conditions are the same: until they graduate junior high school (until the earliest end of March after they became 15 years-old).

Requirements for Subsidy:

- -Children must be registered as Okinawa City Residents and are enrolled in one of the government health insurances.
- -Medical expenses are not eligible if they have already been reimbursed with other allowances, such as public assistance or other medical subsidy systems.
- -There is no limit to income amount.
- -Application for the subsidy will be available from the following month, and no later than a year of the month of treatment.
- *As of December 2016, the payment day for subsidies will change from the 25th to the last day of the month (if it falls on a closed day, the earliest business day before it).
