#### Please note:

<u>September</u> is the payment deadline for the following taxes:

Long-term care insurance premium (4th term)/ National health insurance premium (3rd term)/ Medical care for the elderly insurance premium (3<sup>rd</sup> term).

If you use automatic bank transfers, payments will be withdrawn on October 2nd (Mon). Make sure you have enough money in your bank account the day before.

#### ▶The Exemption of Pension Premiums Before and After Childbirth

The exemption period will be recorded as "paid" and will be reflected in your old-age basic pension amount. For the exempted period you apply under this system, the amount of benefits received will be reflected when you pay the full amount of pension premium. Therefore, even if you have already been approved for exemption from or deferment of National Pension Insurance premiums or special exception for student payment for the period, it will be beneficial for you to apply to this exemption system.



Eligibility: Category1 insured person of the pension system, and those whose delivery date was on February 1, 2019 or later. \*Delivery is defined as a birth that occurs after 85 days (or more than 4 months) of pregnancy (includes stillbirth/miscarriage/early delivery /abortion cases).

Exemption Period: 4 months from the month preceding the month in which the expected date of childbirth or the date of childbirth falls./ In the case of multiple pregnancies it applies from 3 to 6 months before the expected date or the actual delivery date, whichever month it falls in.

Notification Period: At the earliest, you can submit it 6 months before the delivery due date. You can also submit it after the delivery.

Required Documents: Mother and Child Health Record Book or certification issued by the hospital and mother's ID with a face photo.

XID with a face photo and Inkan of the proxy will be required when submitted by a proxy.

XA Power of Attorney will be required if the proxy is not of the same household.

## ▶ Notice Regarding Subsidies for People (Older than 20 Years Old) Who No Longer Apply to the "Medical Expense Grant System for Pediatric Chronic Illness"

This is a subsidy for those who have received grants from the "Medical Expense Grant System for Pediatric Chronic Illness" of were subject to the "Medical Research Project on Pediatric Chronic Illness Treatment" in the past and are still under treatment for a disease caused by a pediatric chronic illness.

Eligibility: You must be an Okinawa City citizen older than 20 years old as of September 1, 2020, registered under the basic resident register, and apply to the conditions below:

-You are currently under treatment for a disease which is caused by a pediatric chronic illness, and able to submit a doctor's diagnosis and other documents to certify your eligibility.

-You are not receiving benefits for a "Medical Expense Subsidy for Severe Physical Disability" or "Special Disability" from Okinawa City. -You are not receiving benefits for medical expenses (designated intractable diseases).

\*If you are not sure if you apply for this grant system, please come to the service window for confirmation.

### **▶** Preventing Your Dog From Escaping

Be careful of your dog's running away.

There have been cases of pit-bull or fighting dogs running away due to carelessness on the part of their owners, such as dogs running away because the leash came off, or dogs running away because the owner forgot to close the gate. This is very dangerous as it may lead to serious bite accidents or traffic accidents caused by your dog..

o prevent your dog from escaping/accidental bite

① Prepare the proper size kennel or cage for your dogs size to prevent your dogs from running away.

Or keep your dog inside the house.

② Make sure your dog's collar and leash are in good condition so your dog doesn't get loose.

Keep your dog on a leash of proper length while walking. The person walking the dog should be able to keep them under control.

3 Register your dogs and get their rabies shot

The owner is obligated by law to have their dogs older than 91 days from birth registered (once) and get rabies shot (yearly). Registered dogs must wear the registration tag and vaccination certificate.

\* All residents, including SOFA status residents, who own dogs in Okinawa City (outside U.S. bases) are obligated to follow this requirement.

Contact the Environmental Division in Okinawa City Hall or Okinawa Police immediately, if you find a loose dog in Okinawa City or if your dog gets loose. When you make a phone call, keep a record of their appearance (color of their hair or collar, dog breed, etc.) If the city hall is closed, call #110 for Okinawa Police Station.
