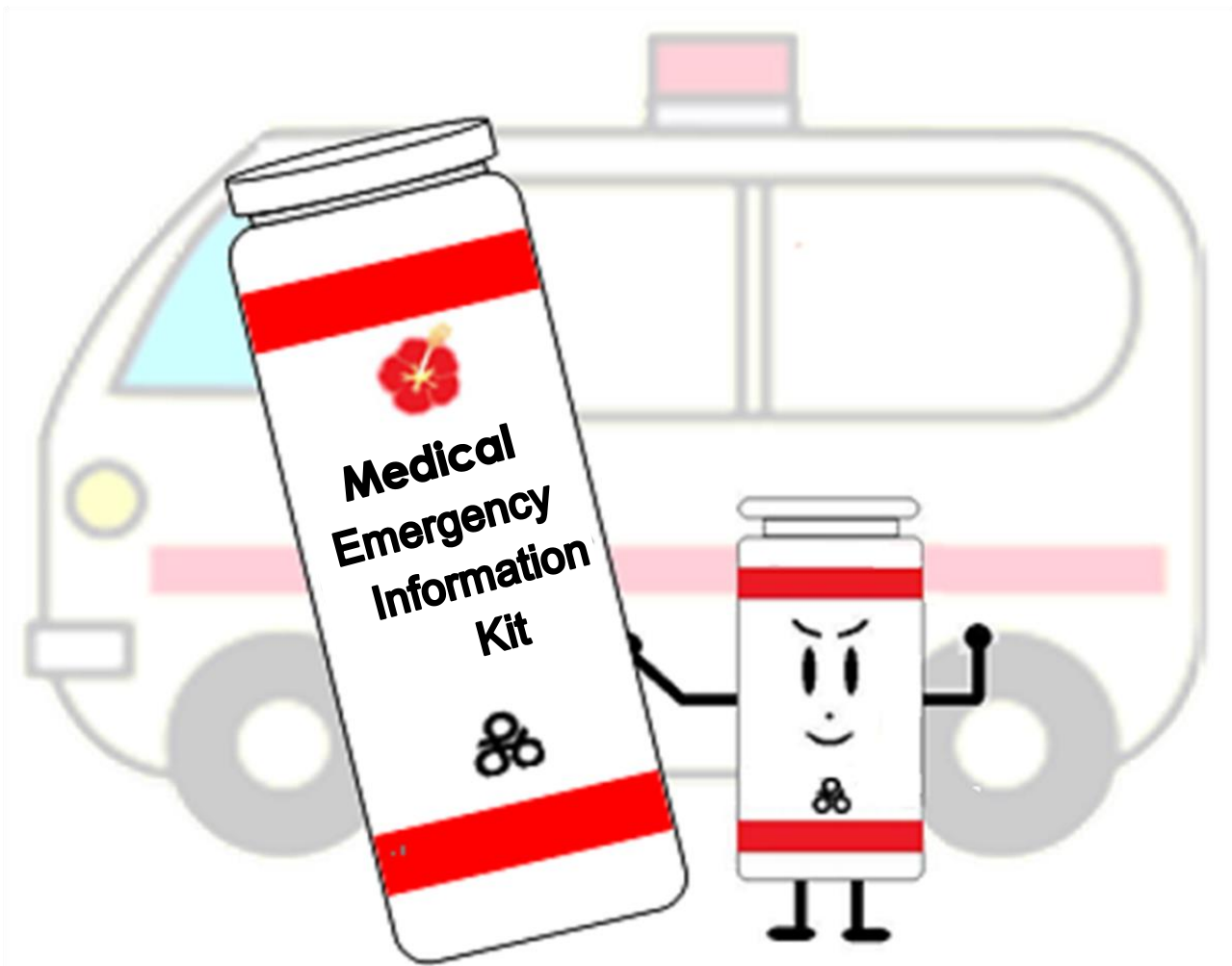

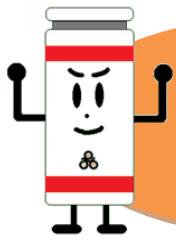

Medical Emergency Information Kit

What's a medical emergency information kit?



In an effort to protect the safety and sense of security among our senior citizens, Okinawa City has put into effect a project to give out free medical emergency information kits to those who are 65 years old, or older.

If you or someone is unable to explain your medical condition in case of an emergency, the information in the kit will be used to help emergency responders to act quickly and appropriately.

What to put inside the medical emergency information kit



① Medical emergency information form.

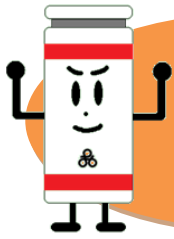
- Emergency contact
- Related medical facility
- Medication being taken

② A copy of your insurance certificate.

③ A copy of your hospital registration card.

④ A copy of your medication information form.

※You must prepare ②~④ yourself.



How do I apply for it and use it?



Eligible Persons

Those who are 65 years old, or older, living in Okinawa City. (1 kit per household.)

Where to Apply

Elderly Welfare Division
Home Care Support Center

You can receive your kit as soon as you apply!



【How to use the kit】

1

Receive the medical emergency information kit and stickers.

2

Fill out the medical information form and put it inside the kit along with a copy of your insurance certificate, etc.

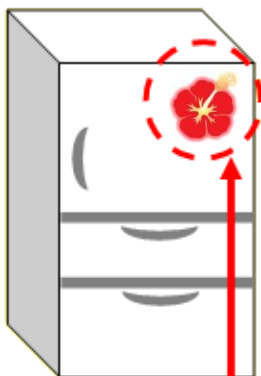
3

Store the medical emergency information kit inside your refrigerator at home.

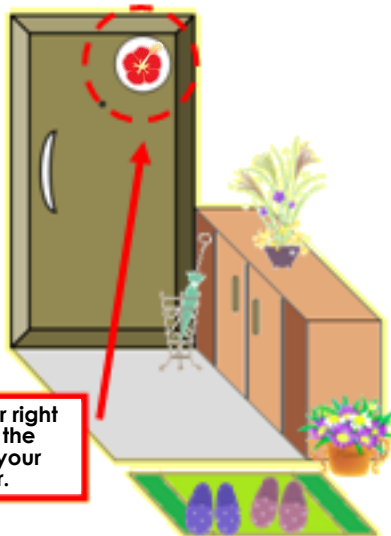
4

Place the sticker on your front door and refrigerator.

Where to place the stickers



The upper right corner on the outside of your refrigerator.



The upper right corner of the inside of your front door.

Where to store the kit



The inside of your refrigerator door.

【Attention】

- Keep the information inside the kit updated. Make **changes** or **revisions** accordingly.
- Put the stickers on the specified places where emergency responders can easily see it.

Please understand the following regarding the usage of the medical emergency information kit.



①

If the sticker is placed on the inside of your front door, emergency responders may open your refrigerator to take out the medical emergency information kit without your consent or the consent of family members.

②

Emergency responders will only use your medical emergency information kit if they determine it is necessary. Depending on the type of action that must be taken, responders may decide that it is unnecessary to use your medical emergency information kit, even if they know it belongs to you.

③

If emergency responders determine that they need to transport you to a medical facility, depending on the condition of your symptoms, you may not be transported to the related medical facility listed on your medical information form.

④

You are responsible for managing and storing your medical emergency information kit. If there are any changes to your medical information, please update the forms inside your emergency kit accordingly.
