


Evacuation Assistance Project

For Those Who Need Assistance During a Disaster

~Application Process~

◆ What the application process includes:

1. You will receive an explanation about what the project includes.
 2. You will be asked about your physical condition, what medication you are taking, your family's contact information, welfare services you are using, and so on in order to create a personal plan.
 3. We will make a copy of the certificate (*techo*) necessary for the application.
 4. You will be asked to fill out the application form.
- ※The application process will take approximately 1 hour.




◆ What you will need for the application process:

- ① Applicable certificate (*techo*). (Long term care insurance certificate, physical disability certificate, intellectual disability certificate, psychiatric disability certificate, etc.)
- ② Any documents that describe the medication you are taking (medication record book, etc.)
- ③ Inkan

◆ What happens after you complete the application process:

Step 1


A notice of determination will be sent to you within approximately 1 week.



Step 2

A municipal administrative staff member and other involved affiliates (Community Association Chairperson, local welfare commissioner, care manager, etc.) will visit your home and share information such as your physical condition, where you will sleep, your evacuation route, and other information written on your personal evacuation plan.

(Affiliates will be present only with the consent of the applicant.)



Step 3

The personal plan will be brought to the your home.

A list, which includes the names of those who have given consent (and which also includes their address and contact information), will be given to the Community Association Chairperson, the local welfare commissioner, the Okinawa City Social Welfare Committee and members of voluntary organizations for disaster prevention to help them in their daily activities of making sure of your safety.

(The list of names will be given to the involved affiliates only with the consent of the applicant.)

Those who are eligible to apply on your behalf:

1. Housemate
2. Relative
3. Local Welfare Commissioner
4. Care Manager , etc.
