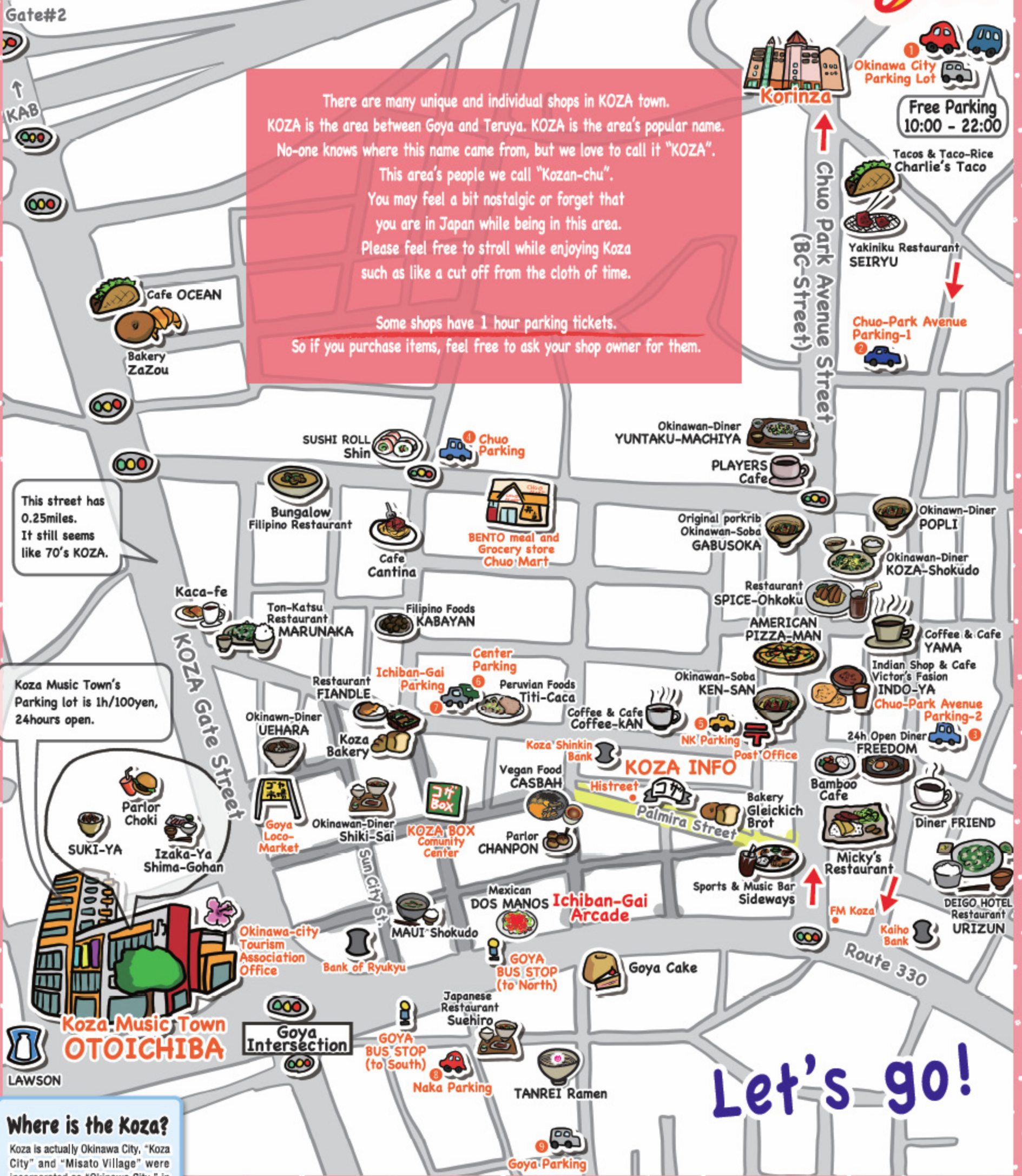


Cafe and Restaurant Map in Koza
