

# 2020 Okinawa City Temporary Benefit for Single Parents

Okinawa City will provide “Temporary Benefit for Single Parents” to support single-parent households to reduce their financial damage due to the COVID-19 infection.

## Amount of Benefit

¥30,000 per household (one-time benefit)

## Eligibility

① Those who received the “Child Rearing Allowance for Single Parent” for April, 2020, and those who have applied for the benefit, or move-in notification for the allowance at Children’s Welfare division, and those who are eligible for this allowance as of April 30, 2020.

✖ If you are not able to receive the allowance because of the income amount limit, you are not eligible for this benefit, either.

✖ If you applied for the “Child Rearing Allowance for Single Parent” on May 1, 2020 or after, you are not eligible for this benefit.

② If you are not able to receive the allowance or under the equivalent status because you are a beneficiary of pension annuity.

③ If you are single parent and your income has been reduced (The details are yet to be announced. Please keep checking on our website for updates about how to apply.)

④ Even if your allowance is suspended because you did not submit a current status report in 2019, or the documents were incomplete, if you complete a current status report and it is approved to be eligible by September 30, 2020, you will be able to receive the benefit.

## When you will receive the benefit

June 22, 2020 (Mon)

\*The benefit will be paid to the same bank account as the allowance.

\*For those who apply to ③&④, the payment will be made as soon as it is through the examination and get approved.
